Lincoln sex offender sentenced to 4-8 years

A former Lincoln Boy Scout leader was declared a mentally disordered sex offender by Lancaster County District Court Judge Donald E. Endacott and sentenced Thursday to four to eight years in the Lincoln Regional Center and prison.

Douglas Shockley, 27, 3013 S St., pleaded no contest in November to a charge of attempted first-degree sexual assault in a plea agreement with the Lancaster County attorney's office. He originally had been charged with first-degree sexual assault.

Shockley assaulted a 14-year-old boy he had met through Boy Scouts, police said. He will be treated in the LRC's Mentally Disordered Sex Offender program until doctors determine he has received maximum benefit from treatment, then he will serve the rest of his sentence at the Lincoln Correctional Center.

Boy Scout leader facing a charge of sexual assault

A Lincoln man was charged in Lancaster County Court Tuesday with sexual assault on a child for allegedly assaulting a 14-year-old boy he had befriended through various youth programs.

Douglas Shockley, 27, 3013 S St., allegedly sexually assaulted the boy on more than one occasion during the past year, said Deputy County Attorney John Colborn.

Shockley, a Boy Scout leader, became acquainted with the youth through Scouting and other youth programs. The youth spent several nights at the Shockley home and the alleged assault occurred there, Colborn said.

Shockley was released on his own recognizance by Judge Jack Lindner with the provision Shockley have no contact with children, according to court records.

We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a council review committee, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated.

THE FACTS:

Mike Watkins acting in the absence of the Scout executive has been informed by the Lincoln Police Department of the arrest of Douglas Shockley, Scoutmaster, Troop 51, Fourth Presbyterian Church of Lincoln on July 14, 1987. He is charged with child sexual abuse.

The case apparently involves circumstances involving a Scout 4 years ago. The youth has just reported the incident to authorities.

ACTIONS OR RECOMMENDATIONS: Mr. Watkins was advised to discuss the matter with the councils' legal counsel who also servers as council president. He is to seek advice on who will serve as spokesman and what will be shared with the media.
