Dear Mr. McCaffrey:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are, therefore, compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the Regional Director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted. The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

Date: February 6, 1991

On Wednesday, February 6, 1991, at 10:30 AM I received a phone call from David Lamoreaux of Troop 2 Central Falls. He asked questions about what he thought was a new Troop at the Salvation Army on Broad Street in Providence. Specifically he said that he had Some "not so good news" about one of the volunteers, Elmer McFerry. I told him that I did not know this individual nor did I ever hear of him before. I asked him what the "not so good news" was and he said that a woman, who he nows, said that she was molested as a youngster years ago by Elmer McFerry but never reported it. I told Dave Lamoreaux that I would check to see if the individual is registered with Troop 386 at the Salvation or any other Scouting unit. I told him that I would get back to him.

I proceeded to check the recently submitted charter papers and there was no mention of Mr. McFerry , and I also checked the membership files on the computer and found no listing.

At approximately 11:30 AM - 12:00 PM, Capt. John Wettlaufer of the Salvation Army happened to stop by and I asked if Mr. McFerry was active with Troop 386 and he confirmed that he was. I briefly explained the situation and asked Capt. Wettlaufer to have Mr. McFerry complete an adult application. I then told the Captain that I would keep him informed.

Afternoon of February 6, 1991, I met with Brad Farmer and explained the situation and Brad said that the woman involved would have to put in writing her concerns and reasons. This information should be sent to the Narragansett Council Scout Executive, Roy Williams.

I called Dave Lamoreaux at approximately 3:00-3:30 PM on February 6, 1991 and left a message for him to call me at the office or at home that evening.

Dave Lamoreaux called back at 5:05 PM. I explained to him that the only way in my understanding that the Narragansett Council can take actions is for the woman to submit her claims, concerns, reasons in a letter to the Scout Executive, Roy Williams.

Dave Lamoreaux is leaving on a vacation trip February 7-10 and will talk to the woman on February 11th.

I will call Dave Lamoreaux on Tuesday, February 12th, to see if the woman is willing to come forward.

I called Dave Lamoreaux on February 12th at 11:35 AM. She is going to construct something. Dave asked if the letter could be sent anonymously, or must it be signed. I said that the letter would be most effective if signed, because anyone could send a letter anonymously. Dave Lamoreaux expressed concerns about confidentiality and I suggested that he talk to Roy Williams regarding procedure.

Copies of this report were given to Roy Williams, scout Executive and Brad Farmer, Director of Field Service on February 22, 1991.

To Whom it May Concern,

I am writing to your about Cloner McCeffery. Affavently, he has just started a Boy Scout Troop in Providence. The Troop number is 386, and they meet every Thursday at the Salvation army on Broad It. in

Providence. There is something about Mr Mclaffry that I believe you should Know about. about 12 year ago, Mr. Mclaffory sejually molisted a ten year old girl, and continued to Sexually abuse her for approximately 4 years. When the girl was fourteen, she finally summoned the courage to tell (Imer (mac)) McCaffery to leave her alone, suchich he did. The gul waited a year and half before she told anyone, and did not seek counseling until She was Bys. although formal Charges were never brought against Elmer McCaffery, some of his family members were recently told. The reason I feel it, is important for you to know this is because that gul was me. at the age of 22, I am still trying to deal with many issues. a large portion of jou was taken from my childhead, and I don't want to see it taken from

to my knowledge, Elmen Mcleffey has not recurred any formal counseling. I also don't think he has sexually molester anyone else. However, I do not feel longotable knowing he is working with children

Therefore I worge you to reconsider his involvement in your organization. Thenk four
