REXBURG — A Rexburg man has pleaded guilty to one count of lewd and lascivious conduct with minor children in a plea bargain that resulted in the dismissal of three other felony charges.

Jared Chabot Murray, 45, of 326 W. Third South, pleaded guilty to a charge of lewd conduct with an 11

vear-old.

According to court records. Murray orginally was charged with three counts of lewd and lascivious conduct and one count of sexual abuse of a child. The charges involve four children under the age of 16.

Bail has been set at \$100,000, but Murray has been released from the Madison County Jail so he can con-

tinue to work.

Sentencing has been scheduled Sept. 25.
