INCIDENT INVOLVING ROBERT OWENS

On August 23, 191, Officer Rand Townley, New Castle County Police, set an appointment and arrived at 3:00 p.m. and met with Dave Reynolds, Director of Field Service, and myself. He asked if a Mr. Robert Owens was involved in Scouting? He is a member of Troop 30, Assistant Scoutmaster.

Detective Townley wants to set up a meeting to give a safety presentation to Troop 30. He says he will find out if any of the youth have had involvement with Mr. Owens. He wants us (Scouts) present at the meeting. We should talk to the Scoutmaster. What it pertains to is that Mr. Owens will be sentenced on August 28, 1991.

A letter denying registration was delivered to Mr. Owens immediately on August 23, 1991, at 5:30~p.m. (See attached letter.)

Dave Reynolds and I delivered the letter to his home, and we had Mr. Owens read the letter. He was asked if he had any questions and he understood the letter. Told him the local police had come to us and told him the local council had evidence and that he does not meet the standards of leadership in the BSA. Told him this was confidential and he should stop all Scouting activities.

Informed him of his right to seek a review and returned his registration fee of \$7.00.

He told us that he had been inactive since about April, and if this was all we came for we just wasted our time. We left.

September 5, 1991 - 7:00 p.m. (Scout Meeting)

Officer Rand Townley came to the meeting of Troop 30 and told us he would like to come back to give his safety presentation at a later date. Told Dave Reynolds and myself and the troop committee he was 99.9% sure none of the kids were involved and he wasn't going to try to interview the kids.

Later, Officer Townley told us outside that the victims were

August 27, 1991

6:45 p.m. - meets with Scoutmaster Barbera.

- 1. Mr. Ownes told Barbera of his arrest in March/April, but Mr. Owens said he is not a homosexual and is pleading not guilty. Barbera told him to disassociate himself from the troop until courts decide fate.
- Barbera said Officer Townley told him it was girls that Mr. Owens molested from age 2 and 5 until they were 10 and 13.
- 3. In March, Barbera asked one boy through his parents and one Assistant Scoutmaster, who had been in the troop as a boy until recently. Boys said there had never been any talk or signs that boys in the troop were involved.

7:00 p.m. - . /Rev. Ralph Ellis/Robert A. Barbera

Rev. Ellis met with us and eight key church members, including chartered representative. Just apprised church members of the situation but assured them of the following:

- Mr. Owens is not a church member, only attended on Scout Sunday.
- 2. No Scouts involved.
- Safety presentation 9/5/91.

Finally, Robert Barbera requested Jim Gentry attend safety presentation and meet with him briefly ahead of time.
