Scout leader pleads guilty to sex counts

SOUTH PARIS — A 48-year-old Rumford boy scout leader has pleaded guilty in Oxford County Superior Court to three counts of unlawful sexual contact and a charge of assault.

Timothy D. Parent entered the plea this week through his attorney Paul Dumas. The case was continued for a pre-sentence investigation, and sentencing is scheduled for early March, said Assistant District Attorney Patricia Mador.

Parent was indicted Jan. 6 on five counts of unlawful sexual contact with young boys and two counts of assault. The incidents took place at his home in Rumford and at his camp in Roxbury, authorities said.

Mador said Parent faces up to five years in jail, up to a \$2,500 fine and maximum probation of four years.
