

Dear Mr. Love:

I have been representing David William Peabody for approximately five years. He has requested that I write to you to provide the Boy Scouts with some information and at the same time seek some information from the Scouts.

For your files and records, I am enclosing a copy of the Motion to Dismiss and Order which dismissed the charges against David with prejudice, meaning they may not be refiled. Because I represented David during that criminal proceeding, I am very familiar with the facts and circumstances surrounding that prosecution. Without detailing information that would be of little interest to the Scouts, let me just say that knowing as much about the case as anyone, except David, it is my personal opinion that David never committed any offense and was in fact the victim of a social and political situation that produced an hysteric reaction. In addition, because the motivation and actions of some of the principals in this situation are suspect, a complex and involved lawsuit is pending against them.

One of the most damaging aspects of being charged with child molestation is the innuendo that remains even after charges are dismissed with prejudice. Much of the concern, especially by volunteer agencies like the Scouts, is understandable given the special and vulnerable position they occupy regarding the children then are involved with. Let me state foremost that I have never heard David say anything but laudatory comments about the Scouts, and certainly the Scouts and those involved are not the focus of any of David's concern. Specifically, to put you at ease, no litigation involving the Scouts is even remotely contemplated by David. However, it is our understanding that the Scouts were provided with certain information by others who are already parties to the litigation I referred to above.

My interest is to identify the source of information that was provided to the Scouts regarding David, to obtain copies and to have the opportunity to correct any errors that may be contained in that information. I am aware that David's credit records contain information about these dismissed charges and that he was quoted a higher than standard life insurance rate because the insurance company's records contained such information. Naturally, I would like to determine how widespread such information may be, particularly since it apparently shows David's arrest and charging but not the dismissal of charges with prejudice. We are also hoping to determine the sources of this information so appropriate corrections and deletions can be made.

We would very much appreciate receiving copies of any information the Scouts were able to obtain regarding David, including the identity of the entity providing the information. Naturally, we expect to pay the reasonable cost of duplicating and mailing that information, and I will personally guarantee payment of such expenses, or if you prefer advance payment, simply advise us of the anticipated costs.

If there is further information that you need, or if you feel that a less formal conversation by telephone would be instructive, please don't hesitate to contact me at your convenience.

Dear Scouts and Scouters,

It is with great sorrow and concern that I am presenting this letter of resignation from all my involvements in Scouting, effective December 31, 1988. Because of my personal problems, I have been uncertain whether I am more of a liability than an asset to Scouting. It has only been because of the continuous and constant friendship, trust and support of the many scouts and scouters that I have been able to continue my involvement this long. I owe each of these friends, and others, a debt of graditude that can never be repaid.

My concerns stem from recent policy changes by the National Boy Scouts of America. First, the policies are unwritten which I consider dangerous to everybody involved. Any policy worth having is surely worth putting in writing and making available to all. I am adamantly opposed to the following policies:

1. There is to be no physical discipline of any scout for any reason.

2. No adult is to lay a hand on any scout for any reason, including returning a hug.

3. Each adult must stay in eye sight of at least one other adult at all times, including during a scout-master's conference.

More and more prisoners are coming forward stating that they got into serious trouble because nobody cared enough, or dared, to discipline them when they first started getting into trouble. Psychiatrists and psychologists are starting to speak out on the importance of nurturing touching in the form of hugs, pats on the back, and a reassuring hand on a child's shoulder by parents, teachers, and other important adults in a child's life, such as a scout leader. Some are even reporting that refusal to give a child such nurturing touches can be at least as abusive as inappropriate touching.
