Contacted Warren Page in the Whatcom County Prosecutor's Office at Bellingham, this date to determine the status or disposition of John Petrie's case.

The case has gone to Deferred Prosecution for two years. This means that no action will be taken for two years provided that John Petrie:

- 1. Obtains and responds to therapy for sex offenders, and
- 2. That he have no association with youth or youth organizations in this period.

Mr. Pager asked that if we get any information that John Petrie is attempting or has become involved in any youth organization that his office be notified immediately.

Mr. Page also stated that the Deferred Prosecution agreement should be firmed within two to three weeks. I stated that I would contact him at this point to confirm the status.


