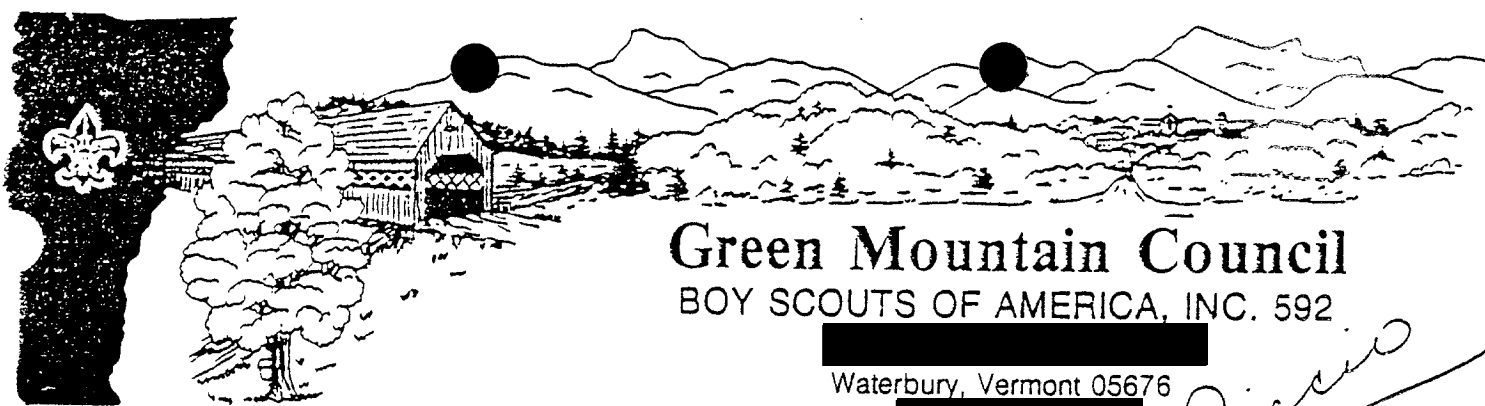

Principal Won't Face Sex Charges

Criminal charges of sexual abuse on children against a former Irasburg Elementary School Principal cannot be brought because the alleged incidents occurred more than four years ago, Orleans County State's Attorney Philip H. White said Wednesday.

James Riccio, who is under investigation by the state's attorney's office for reports of alleged misconduct, resigned from his job in September.

White said the statute of limitations — the time period in which charges can be filed — in this case is July 1, 1982. The statute for most crimes is three years. The Legislature increased the limit on sexual abuse this year to six years, but provided for a gradual increase.

The report by Investigator Donald R. Stubbs showed two former students indicated that Riccio engaged in inappropriate sexual conduct with them, White said. The alleged incidents occurred on school property while the students were in seventh grade, White said.

Stubbs has been asked to continue his investigation of children who may have had more recent contact with Riccio, who has been a Scout leader for several years, White said.

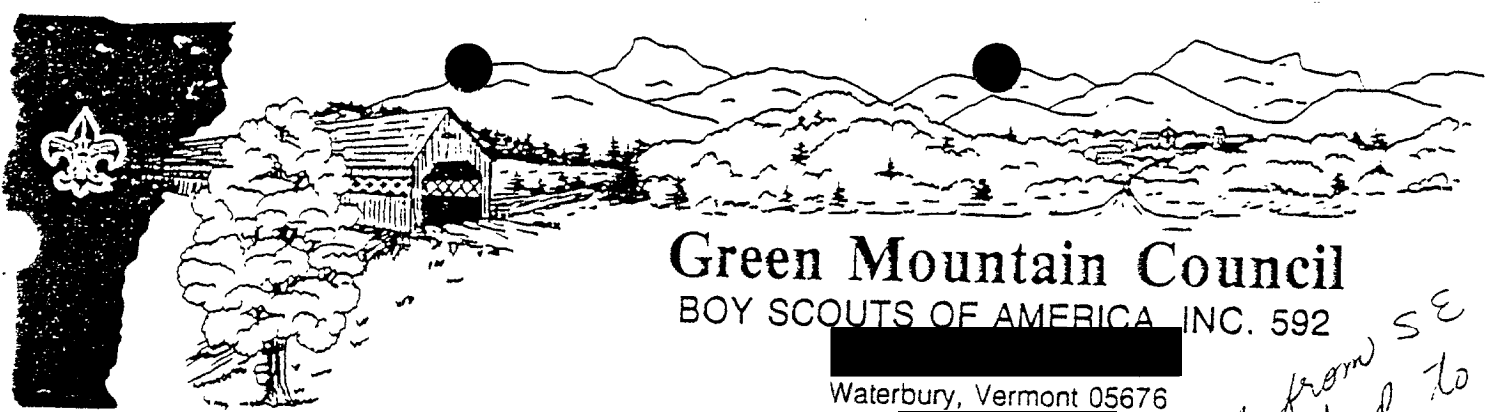
"I am also asking any parents of children who have knowledge or suspicions regarding inappropriate behavior between Mr. Riccio and their children to please contact my office and talk with Don Stubbs," said White in a prepared statement.

Riccio, reached at his Barton home, said he had not been notified of the results of the investigation into the initial complaint against him. He declined to comment on the investigation.

Riccio's resignation letter, which was accepted by the board a month ago, said he wanted a "career change."

Riccio taught math and science for 10½ years at the Irasburg School in addition to handling the administrative duties, Superintendent Paul W. Henry has said. The Lyndon State College graduate taught at Brownington for 1½ years before taking the Irasburg job, Henry said.

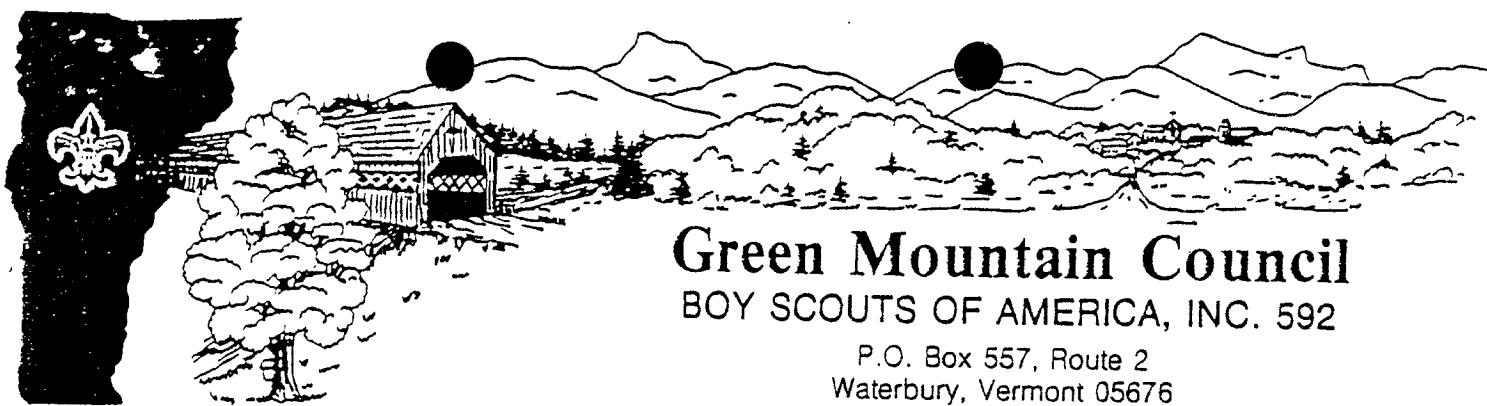

Irasburg Principal Quits, Faces Probe

James Riccio, the teaching principal at the Irasburg Elementary School, has resigned and a criminal investigation of him has begun, according to state and school officials.

A group of about 10 parents, students, teachers and the town School Board was told Tuesday night that a complaint involving a juvenile had been filed Tuesday with the Orleans County State's Attorney's Office, authorities said.

Investigator Donald R. Stubbs said the complaint was filed by the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services concerning a juvenile. But he was unable to provide many details. Stubbs said he was not interested in rumors that were circulating, but wanted people to step forward if they knew any information.

Riccio's resignation letter said he wanted a "career change," according to Paul W. Henry, superintendent for the Orleans-Essex North School District.

School Board Chairman David Turner said he first learned Sept. 5 from Henry that there might be an allegation made.

Attempts to reach Riccio in Boston were unsuccessful. His wife, Sandra, said her husband was not home. She said she would not, and he probably would not, make

State's Attorney Phillip H. White, who said he sent Stubbs to the meeting, also declined to elaborate on the specific type of charge made against Riccio.


White said the nature of the charge, if substantiated in Stubbs' investigation, would normally mean a criminal charge could be filed.

"He (Stubbs) has talked to some of the people, but he hasn't talked with all of the people," White said. The investigation could be completed by the end of next week if there is only one incident to check, officials said.

Henry said Riccio has taught math and science for 10½ years at the Irasburg Elementary School, besides handling the administrative duties. The Lyndon State College graduate taught in Brownington for 1½ years before taking the Irasburg job, he said.

Riccio submitted his resignation two weeks ago, but did not work out his notice, Henry said. During the Tuesday night meeting, the board officially accepted the resignation of Riccio and another junior high school teacher, who taught English. Henry said the second resignation was unrelated to Riccio's departure.

Turner said replacements will be sought immediately for both positions. The school, for kindergarten through grade 8, has about 135 students.
