Jury Acquits Des Peres Man Of Sodomizing Boy In 1986

David Sahrmann, a firefighter for Brentwood, was acquitted Friday of sodomizing a 12-year-old boy.

A jury in St. Louis County Circuit Court deliberated about one hour before returning the verdict.

The boy, now 13, accused Sahrmann of committing the sex act at Sahrmann's home in Des Peres in the summer 1986. Sahrmann, 42, was an adviser for an Explorer group that meets in Des Peres.

Prosecuting Attorney William L. Meiners also called two other youths, who testified that Sahrmann had sodomized them between five and 10 times each. Meiners said the statute of limitations on those acts had expired; he said the acts had happened four and five years ago.

Defense Attorney Charles M. Shaw called 34 character witnesses who testified on behalf of Sahrmann.

"At no time has that man done anything to harm any child," Shaw said. Sahrmann wept and dabbed his eyes with a handkerchief when Shaw cited the testimony of his friends.

Meiners urged the jury to send a

message to the community that children who join scouting organizations will not be molested.


The five-day trial was before Circuit Judge Alphonso H. Vorhees.

Man, 20, Charged In Sewer Killing

Steven Bryan Cook, 20, was arrested and charged late Thursday with first-degree murder in the death of a man whose body was pulled from a storm drain on Easter Sunday in north St. Louis.

Cook was charged in the death of Roland Clayborn, 27, of the 1800 block of East Prairie Avenue. Cook, of the 4900 block of Alcott Avenue, St. Louis, was arrested at 8 p.m. Thursday in the 5000 block of North Kingshighway.

The suspect told police that he and others had beaten Clayborn on Feb. 16 during a fight over the quality of some drugs Clayborn is alleged to have sold to Cook, said Edward Sweeney, assistant circuit attorney.

Ex-Scoutmaster Accused Of Sexual Abuse

A former Explorer scoutmaster in Des Peres has been charged with sodomy involving a 12-year-old boy from Rock Hill, Des Peres police say.

Davis Louis Sahrmann, 41, of 900 block of Des Peres Drive, was charged Thursday with one count of sodomy by the St. Louis County prosecuting attorney's office.

Sahrmann has been a firefighter with the Brentwood Fire Department for the last 12 years. He was suspended without pay Friday by the municipality, Brentwood Fire Chief Robert

Niemeyer said. Niemeyer said Fire Department officials knew "absolutely nothing" about any allegations against Sahrmann.

Des Peres police say the incident took place between June 1 and July 31 of last year at Sahrmann's home. The boy had gone there in connection with activities of the Rock Hill Explorer Post, police said. The victim first confided in his parish priest, who persuaded the boy and his family to tell authorities, police said.
