I received your letter inquiring as to the disposition of Mr. William Stanley Schilling's case. I checked with Undersheriff Eric Cooper of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and was informed that through the process of plea bargaining, Mr. Schilling plead guilty to a gross misdemeanor of indecent exposure with a minor and was sentenced to one year imprisonment which was suspended and he was fined \$1,200.

Although it appears that Mr. Schilling got off light, we do have a sexual conviction against him.

I have been further informed that Shilling has left Las Vegas. I suspect that he probably is now living with his mother in Salem, Ohio.



Dear Mr. Gasparo:

I have enclosed a newspaper article recently appearing in the Las Vegas Review Journal concerning allegations of sexual misconduct against William S. Shilling. I am well acquainted with Mr. Shilling, having served on the Committee for Troop 208. In addition, each of my sons have been enrolled as scouts with that troop since 1985.

The black eye which scouting has suffered in this community could easily have been avoided if the council had taken the simple expedient of doing a background investigation on Shilling before allowing him to become a scoutmaster. This is easily achieved by simply requiring an applicant to consent to the release of any information in the possession of law enforcement concerning prior arrests. This method is used by prospective employers in the casino industry in this community and there is no reason why it cannot be followed by the council. It might also have the effect of reducing insurance rates which inevitably result from litigation.

Please let me know what steps are being taken to remedy this situation.

# Ex-teacher charged in sexual abuse of boy

A Las Vegas elementary school teacher, who lost his job with the school district, has been charged with sexually abusing a 12-year-old boy during a Boy Scout trip to California last summer.

William S. Schilling, 39, who also is a former Boy Scout leader with the Boulder Dam Area Council, remains free on \$5,000 bail. He faces an April 18 preliminary hearing in Justice Court on a charge of lewdness with a minor.

Schilling was booked into the Clark County Detention Center on Feb. 13, the same day school district officials placed him on involuntary resignation, terminating his job as a fifth-grade teacher at Decker Elementary School. He began teaching in Clark County in 1978.

This is not the first time that Schilling has faced criminal sex charges involving juveniles, police said.

In 1979, he was charged with six counts of indecent exposure after an investigation by the Metropolitan Police Department.

Three of the charges were dismissed in Justice Court. Schilling was bound over for trial in District Court on the three remaining counts.

Two of the counts were later dismissed and, in a plea agreement with the district attorney's office, the third count was reduced to a misdemeanor charge of disorderly conduct to which Schilling pleaded no contest and was fined \$500.

The latest case was investigated by detective Sam Hilliard, who is assigned to the Police Department's sexual assault detail.

In an affidavit filed in Justice Court, Hilliard stated that Schilling sexually abused a 12-year-

old boy during a July 18 Boy Scout camping trip at Camp Whitsett in Southern California. Police allege that Schilling had the youth asleep in a tent with him.

Dan Gasparo, executive director of the Boy Scouts Boulder Dam Area Council, said that Schilling was removed as a Scout leader on Nov. 23, after Scout officials learned of the allegation.

"There is no room in the Boy Scouts for that type of behavior," Gasparo said. "Scouting has to be a safe haven for kids, the safest place they can be."

Gasparo said he understands that police are continuing their investigation to see if other children come forward with allegations of sexual misconduct against Schilling, who had been a Scout leader for several years.

Police said they are also urging the district attorney's office to file a new charge of indecent exposure against Schilling, stemming from allegations that he exposed himself to three children who were outside his residence sometime in September 1989.

Schilling had not reported to work at Decker Elementary School since mid-December. Timothy Harney, director of personnel for the school district, said the district decided to move against Schilling after he went on extended sick leave without ever providing school officials with a viable explanation for his absence.

Police said that Schilling is not suspected of molesting any children from Decker Elementary.

According to police, at one point in the investigation, Schilling left Las Vegas to stay with his mother in Ohio. He was later arrested in Ohio on the lewdness warrant and brought back to Las Vegas.

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be denied. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to refuse registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not meet the high standards of membership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed by a BSA regional review committee, please write to the regional director within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be reinstated. The procedure for a review of this decision are attached.
