### STATEMENT OF REASONS. R. 3-21-4

- 1. That the defendant should be punished for the serious crimes be committed.
- That sufficient punishment should be imposed upon the defendant, to demonstrate to the general public, what is in store for those members of our society, who resort to such criminal conduct in the future, as the defendant did in this case.
- That sufficient punishment should be imposed upon the defendant, to demonstrate to said defendant, what is in store for him, should be continue to resort to such criminal conduct in the future, as he did in this case.
- 4. That the defendant either knew, or should have known, the vulnerability of the victims, while he was committing the crimes in question.
- 5. I find that a lesser sentence, than a custodial sentence, for the defendant's criminal conduct in this case, would depreciate the seriousness of the crime the defendant committed in this case.
- 6. I find that the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center has determined that the defendant fall within the purview of the New Jersey Sex Offender Act, in that the defendant's conduct in this case was characterized by a pattern of repetitive compulsive behavior.
- 7. I find that based upon the defendant's criminal conduct in this matter, and everything else that is before me, that the defendant is in need of a program of specialized treatment for his mental condition, and that such treatment can only be provided effectively to him, by a substantial custodial commitment, no the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center at Avenel.
- 8. I find that based upon the defendant's criminal conduct in this matter, and everything else that is before me, that there would be an undue risk to the public, if the defendant were permitted to remain in society, without first undergoing a program of specialized treatment for his mental condition in that the defendant would continue to commit the type of crime in the future, that he committed in this case.
- 9. That the defendant should be punished by the imposition of consecutive sentences, separated for each of those victims, the defendant committed crimes against in this matter.
- 10. I find and I am clearly convinced that in giving due regard to both the aggravating factors and the mitigating factors that may exist in this matter, that the aggravating factors, as just enumerated, are not substantially outweighed by the mitigating factors, in favor of a non-custodial sentence, for the crimes in question.

Gentlemen:

The enclosed news article refers to Mr. John Sileo, 168 Bloomfield Ave., Nutley, NJ 07110, Birthday May 1961, formerly registered as a Den Assistant in Pack 145, sponsored by Radcliff School PTA. Nutley, from October 1980 to October 1981.

Mr. Sileo has been denied registration locally due to a Neurological Impairment which causes difficulty in relating and functioning as an Adult Leader. We did not and could not find any indication of moral problems as indicated in this article. Pack 145 registered him as an Assistant; however, soon after registration, did not allow him to continue in their activities. His problems were reviewed with the Nutley Family Services Agency over the past 3½ years and we have avoided registering him except for this aforementioned period since he was a Scout in Troop 159, a Troop for the mentally handicapped, when he was under 13 years of age.

Michael Abidiwan is an Eagle Scout as of July 29, 1982, and is currently registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster in Troop 147, sponsored by Franklin Reformed Church, Nutley, N.J. until February 1984.

I have informed their Troop Leaders and Church Pastor that we are suspending his membership and requesting his membership card and Eagle credentials and badge be returned.

The Detective in charge of this case will furnish additional information including both men's description in the first week of December and I will forward the full report to you at that time.

# Nutley cultist facing new sex charges

Further charges will be filed against a 22-yearold man arrested last week in connection with a devil-worshiping sex cult involving at least 35 teenagers. Nutley police said yesterday.

"At this point, this is far from over,

Police Chief Robert DeLitta said.

John Sileo of 168 Bloomfield Ave. was arrested after police raided his home and confiscated various drug paraphernalia and sexually oriented material. DeLitta said: Also taken from Sileo's residence were three rifles and two handguns, which police said Sileo legally possessed.

Sileo was charged with three sex offenses and is being held in the Essex County Jail, Newark, in lieu of \$75,800 boart.

An investigation into Sileo's activities was started three weeks ago when some of the parents of the teenaged victims complained to police. Delitta-said-

Suiso lured his victims, was ranged from 15 to-+17, with drugs and alcohol, said Det. Sgt. John Holland, in charge of the investigation.

The facts: John Sileo, 22, Nutley, NJ arrested 11/16/83 on 3 "sex offense" charges stemming from an alleged satonic cult operating in Nutley area and involving some 35 boys and girls age 15. 16 and 17. Drugs, alcohol, weapons, and an array of sexual material allegedly involved. Sileo WAS assistant cubmaster Pack 145, Radcliffe School, Nutley, through Oct. 1982. NOT NOW REGISTERED.
Michael Abidiwan, 19, Eagle Scout, CURRENTLY registered ASM Troop 147, Franklin Reformed Church, Nutley, involved. Extent, details of his involvement not immediatley known.
