A Houston middle school teacher accused of fondling a special education student repeatedly during the last school year was awaiting trial on similar charges in Florida when the Houston Independent School District hired him, officials said Wednesday.

HISD Superintendent Joan Raymond said school officials were unaware of fondling charges against Michael David Stein when they hired him in October to be a special education teacher.
