Re: Allegations regarding adult Scouter

I am a family therapist and work for a private, non-profit agency in attempting to help families work out their problems which might result in the placement of their children in foster care. As such, I am frequently called upon to deal with abuse issues. I am also a mandatory reporter under the Code of Iowa, Iowa State law, and as such am required to report child abuse to the State Department of Human Services. I was, prior to this employ, employed by the Department. In this work, I am also called upon to maintain confidentiality for my clients, and the following is reported to Boy Scouts of America with a recognition of my duty to Scouting as a Scoutmaster, but also my duty to my client and her confidentiality. Therefore, the identity of my client, hereafter called informant, must remain confidential and I cannot identify her in this document.

In working with this informant, she was reporting considerable anger regarding individuals who sexually abuse their children. While this may be transference of anger from a situation more closely relating to her, and having nothing to do with the Scouter herein mentioned, this anger and her personal knowledge and, according to her, personal acquaintance and/or friendship with a handicapped adult son of the family is what motivates her to report the following to me, her counselor.

She reports that John Tillman, currently a Scoutmaster with an handicapped Scout troop, was engaged in sexual abuse with his daughter, [REDACTED] during her teens and early twenties. According to my informant, John's wife was incapacitated due to alcoholism and unable to "provide for John's sexual needs", that [REDACTED] filled those needs and had sex with him, for money, and that she felt ok about this. My informant also reports that John made a statement in the recent past about this, saying that he felt ok about this event now, had received counseling regarding it, and wished that everyone would stop raising it since it was over and done with. My informant related her feeling that John was bragging about the abuse, but further conversation with her revealed the possibility that John simply was trying to put this event behind him, having had counseling. My informant reported that John said his counselor told him that it was ok. She took this up to mean that the abuse was ok, whereas it could well mean that now that he

has stopped the abuse and worked through it, he wishes to
conclude this episode of his life.

I report this with considerable sorrow, as I have high respect for
John, even if the allegations prove true. While he may have
problems, even psychological difficulties which may have led him to
this, he has also provided service to youth and the Scouting
organization which cannot go unheeded.

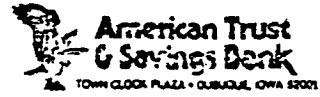

CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE (JOHN TILLMAN)

February 1, 1989 at approximately 10:00 a.m.

I received a phone call from [REDACTED], a Scoutmaster in the council and a member of the staff at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] informed me that an accusation was made of John Tillman, Scoutmaster of Troop 9 chartered to the Dubuque County Association for Retarded Citizens. The informant (contact through [REDACTED] work) claimed that John sexually abused his daughter when she was living at home. The daughter is currently in her late twenties. The incident(s) allegedly happened when she was under 18 years of age. Paul informed me that he would not be able to provide me with the name of his informant. He told me that he made contact with the Department of Human Services and that they informed him that they would not be investigating the accusation because of the time duration and because he currently does not have minor children living in his home.

February 1, 1989 at approximately 1:00 p.m.

I communicated the situation regarding the accusation made against John Tillman with Council President Wayne Stoppelmoor.

February 2, 1989 at approximately 11:00 a.m.

I informed John Young, Area Director of the details regarding the accusation made against John Tillman. John suggested I make whatever contacts I can with the authorities to substantiate the accusation and that I contact Dave Park, (legal counsel for the National Council) to get his opinion on how to proceed. John also suggested that I substantiate the fact that the Department of Human Services know that Tillman was a Scoutmaster when they decided not to investigate the reported accusation.

February 2, 1989 at approximately 7:00 p.m.

I communicated with [REDACTED] to substantiate the fact that the Department of Human Services ~~were~~ ^{were} aware that John Tillman was a Scoutmaster.

February 3, 1989 at approximately 10:00 a.m.

Contacted Department of Human Services to find out if a file or history existed regarding the accusation made against John Tillman. They would not share any information with me and said I would need to get Mr. Tillman's permission to examine any file that might exist regarding the accusation.

February 3, 1989 . . . Throughout the day

I attempted to phone the national office to make Dave Parks aware of the situation and to get his professional advise. I attempted to do this at least 6 times with no success and finally concluded that a problem existed with the phone system at national office.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 9:00 a.m.

I made contact with Mr. Park's office and left a message to have him call me when he returns to his office.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 2:00 p.m.

Mr. Parks returned my call. I explained the accusation made against John Tillman. Park recommended that I have a meeting with John Tillman to question him about the accusation made against him. He also suggested that I suspend Tillman's registration (following proper procedures) if there is any question or doubt as to whether or not the alledged relationship actually occurred.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 2:30 p.m.

Contacted Mike Coyle our council attorney to share the situation with him and to get his advice. He agreed that I should meet with Mr. Tillman to make him aware of the accusation. He suggested that I have Mr. Tillman put in writing his authorization allowing me to examine any files that might exist.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 3:00 p.m.

Contacted Council President Wayne Stoppelmoor to brief him of the situation as it currently existed.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 4:05 p.m.

Made contact with John Tillman and requested that he meet with me at the Scout Office shortly after 5:00 p.m.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 4:15 p.m.

Contacted Wayne Stoppelmoor to request that he join me for my meeting with John Tillman. Wayne was briefed in detail regarding current developments and the plan of action for our meeting with Tillman.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 4:45 p.m.

Met with Wayne Stoppelmoor to review the suspension letter and the hold harmless note prepared for our meeting with Mr. Tillman.

February 6, 1989 at approximately 5:05 p.m.

Meet with John Tillman. Told him we were not accusing him of anything, that we were made aware of an accusation against him and as a precaution to protect the Scouts, we needed to ask him some questions. He was told that he didn't need to tell us anything he didn't wish us to know. Mr. Tillman confirmed the fact that he had a sexual relationship with his daughter about 13 years ago. He shared with us an alcohol problem his wife was having at the time which he felt was responsible for his relationship with his daughter. He informed us of a nervous breakdown he had during this time and of the psychiatric treatment he received. Mr. Tillman cooperated completely and signed the hold harmless note which relieved the Scouts and other agencies from liability for releasing information regarding the accusation made against him. Mr. Tillman accepted the letter of registration suspension, and the pro-rated check as reimbursement of his registration fee.

February 7, 1989 at approximately 8:45 a.m.

I contacted Paul Ernst's office at the National Council. Mr. Ernst was not available so I communicated the Tillman situation to his associate, Clare Miller. Ms. Miller was made aware that Mr. Tillman's registration has been suspended and that his pro-rated membership fee was refunded. She requested that we provide a chronological explanation of what occurred to this point. That we also send a copy of Mr. Tillman's original membership application (if available) and a completed confidential record sheet on him.

February 7, 1989 at approximately 9:45 a.m.

Paul Ernst called to review the Tillman situation with me. He confirmed the fact that I should continue to conduct my own investigation since the Department of Human Services and the Law Enforcement authorities would not. Even though the status of limitations enters into this situation, it was felt that we were certainly justified in taking the action we have to this point.

February 8, 1989 at approximately 4:00 p.m.

Communicated with Sue Davidson, Director of Human Services regarding the situation. She informed me that the release note signed by John Tillman was not sufficient for me to have access to any confidential files that might exist. She explained that John Tillman would have to file a form with her agency requesting a copy of any confidential information that might exist. Once he receives this information, he can do with it as he pleases.

February 8, 1989 at approximately 4:30 p.m.

Placed a call with [REDACTED] in an attempt to secure information regarding John Tillman's psychological sessions held 13 years ago. [REDACTED] was not available but I was told he would call me back tomorrow. John Tillman provided me with [REDACTED] name when we met on February 6.
