William Edward Tyree, 36, a former youth coordinator for the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority, has been sentenced in Richmond Circuit Court to 12 years in prison on two counts of aggravated sexual battery involving 12-year-old boys.

Tyree, formerly of the 6400 block.
Windcroft Road, was sentenced yesterday by Judge Frank A.S. Wright.
The judge suspended another sixyear sentence on a third aggravated sexual battery count.

Tyree pleaded guilty to the charges March 11. At Tyree's trial a juvenile detective told Wright that all the charges involved fondling.

The defendant was scoutmaster for a troop sponsored by the housing authority. The boys were members of the troop.

In February, Tyree was sentenced to five years in prison, with three years suspended, for sodomizing a 16-year-old Richmond youth at a camp in Goochland County.

Morals case guilty pleas entered

The former youth coordinator for the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority pleaded guilty today in Richmond Circuit Court to three counts of aggravated sexual battery involving 12-year-old boys. The defendant, William Edward

Tyree. 26. formerly of the 3400 block Windcroft Road, is to be sentenced April 11. He faces up to 10 years in prison on each of the charges.

Tyree was sentenced last month to five years in prison, with three years suspended, for sodomizing a 16-year-old Richmond youth at Camp Brady Saunders, a camp operated by the Robert E. Lee Council of the Boy Scouts of America in Gocchland County.

He was scourmaster for a troop sponsored by the housing authority.

All of the boys he is accused of melesting were members of the troop.

Tyree had been scheduled to be tried today by a jury but changed his mird yesterday and pleaded guilty this morning before Richmond Circuit Judge Frank A.S. Wright.

Juvenile detective Stephen T. Howard told Wright that the charges involved fondling.

After hearing Howard's testimony. Wright asked each of the boys and Tyree whether Howard's summary was substantially correct. All four said that it was, and Wright then convicted Tyree of the offenses.

Tyree was arrested in May on the sodomy charge, and detectives discovered that other boys had been molested when they interviewed members of the troop, authorities said.

Scout leader gets 2 years in sex case

GOOCHLAND — A former Boy Scout leader has been sentenced to two years in prison after pleading guilty to sodomizing a 16-year-old Richmond youth during a Scouting function here at Camp Brady Saunders in September 1984.

William Edward Tyree, 38. of the 6400 block Windcroft Road in Richmond, pleaded guilty in Goochland County Circuit Court to one count of sodomy, said Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney Gerald T. Massie.

....

Judge F. Ward Harkrader Jr. sentenced Tyree to five years in prison with three years suspended. Tyree was a resident services adviser for the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority and served as liaison between Boy Scouts and the authority.

He also was ordered to pay for any psychological counseling the youth, now 17, receives.

Tyree orginally had been charged with forcible sodomy, but the charge

was reduced to sodomy, Massie said.

He is awaiting trial March 11 in Richmond on three counts of aggravated sexual battery of a minor. He has been charged with sexually molesting three Boy Scouts in separate incidents during overnight trips at the Blackwell Community Center in South Richmond and the Wickham Court center in the East End.

Those incidents occurred between December 1984 and June 1985, court records showed.

Tyree often substituted as a leader for Richmond area troops, an official with the Robert I. Lee Council of the Boy Scouts of America said.

Molestation counts certified

A Richmond judge yesterday certified to a grand jury child abuse charges against a Richmond Scoutmaster accused of sexually molesting boys in his troop.

Juvenile court Judge Willard H. Douglas certified the case against William Edward Tyree. 36, a youth coordinator with the Richmond Redecoordinator with the Richmond Redecoordinator.

velopment and Housing Authority. Tyree is accused of three counts of aggravated sexual battery of a minor. The grand jury is scheduled to convene Nov. 14.

Tyree, of the \$400 block of Windcroft Road, faces additional charges on related alleged incidents in Goochland County.

The three victims testified that Tyree mõlested them repeatedly in separate incidents during overnight sleeping trips from December 1984 to June 1985 at the Blackwell Community Center in Southside and the Wickham Court center in the East End.



It's a case of the right man in the right job. according to Capital District Executive Cieve L. (Lanny) Anderson and Associate DE George C. Smith Jr. "The key to the whole situation is that we have a good relationship with the authority management staff." George Smith said. "They're supportive of Scouting as part of their overall community concept." And, Lanny Anderson noted, when Bill Tyree appeared on the scene there were 11 packs, troops, and posts in the developments, most of them weak: today there are 24, most of them strong.

Unit meetings are held in the community rooms of the housing developments: one development even has a room exclusively for Scouting.

Only about a third of the boys and leaders have uniforms, but the number is growing. The housing authority pays Scouts for cleaning up, trimming hedges, and performing other chores around the developments, and also keeps a fist of part-time job openings to enable Scouts to earn money for uniforms and unit expenses.

All 24 units are chartered to tenant councils, the elected body in each development which is responsible for community activities. The Explorer posts have cosponsors, too, in their career-interest fleids—journalism, radio, photography, Christian education, emergency services, modeling, professional sports, and urban studies.

Journalism Post 437 in the Hillside Court development has as its Advisor John Templeton, editor of the Richmond Afro-American, and an old Life Scout from Winston-Salem, N.C. Last year the post published a newsletter for Hillside Court, contributed to Tenant Progress, the authority's newspaper for residents, and visited the Washington Post and Richmond News Leader Times-Dispatch offices. This year, according to Virginia Tyson, post founder and president, and Audrey Anderson, vice-president, the post is widening its focus to include arrug anuse saucutton.




That's a fairly typical program for a journalism post. Not so typical is the urban studies post, which aims to broaden the horizons of young people in public housing. "What it does is give our young people the opportunity to look at themselves in terms of where they live, why it's the way it is, and where they can go from here." William Tyree said. "They learn what it takes to go to college, how to get a job, and how to look into the military as a career.

"Parental support for Scouting is absolutely super in the developments." Bill Tyree said. "The parents really want to make sure their kids can be in Scouting." Because the vast majority of families are headed by mothers, nearly all of the Cub Scout den leaders. Cubmasters, unit committee members, and Scouting coordinators are women.

Finding Scoutmasters is another story. "The problem is." Bill Tyree said, "that men in the developments who are of the caliber to serve as role models for our youngsters are normally working two jobs: they're trying for upward mobility to remove their families from public housing."

So most of the Scoutmasters are recruited from outside. "We use the techniques recommended by the BSA." Bill Tyree said. He explained that he watches the newspapers for forties about men who
