# Defendart also was abuse victim

A former Boy Scout official from Russiaville who pleaded guilty to molesting one of his young charges was himself molested by his Scout leader, according to Howard Circuit Court testimony.

Thomas E. VanTyle, 26, was described as a "perpetrator and a victim" during his sentencing hearing before Judge R. Alan

Brubaker. VanTyle's attorney John Wood, told the court VanTvie was molested as a child by James A. Hanson, who was then the Scoutmaster of Troop 519.

Hanson, 47, 1050 W. Road 150 South, Russiaville, also faces charges of child molestation in Circuit Court from an investigation conducted by the Howard County Sheriff Department. Efforts to reach Hanson or his at-

A former assistant Scoutmaster r Troop 519, VanTyle admitted it he had fondled or touched a oung member of the troop during June 1990. Although he was formaily charged with two Class D felony counts of child molestation. he was suspected of molesting 10 boys, Chief Deputy Prosecutor Domenica A. Martino said.

According to Dr. James Reed, a psychotherapist from Indianapolis, VanTyle's behavior involving young boys was a model. and a repeat of sexual behavior he had experienced at the hands of his Scoutmaster. The molestation of VanTyle began at age 11, when he was a member of Troop 519, Wood said. The incidents continued up to the time he was arrested on the Circuit Court charges, Wood said.

Diagnosed as mildly mentally retarded. VanTyle grew up in a home without a father figure, and was described in court as "a follower."

Wood told Brubaker he was not making excuses for his client, but he said he wanted the judge "to understand what happened here."

Acting on a request from Wood and a recommendation from a Howard County probation official Brubaker suspended a three-year prison sentence, and placed Van-Tyle on supervised probation for three years. Brubaker said he suspended the prison term because of the circumstances of the case, and because VanTyle was also a "victim."

The judge ordered VanTyle to continue counseling that he started last August, because of depression related to the child molestation charges. Brubaker also ordered VanTyle to avoid any supervision of children under the age of 18 during his probation.

Before the sentence was imposed, Reed testified that "with restrictions," VanTyle was "a low

risk" of being a repeat offender. But Reed added that the former Boy Scout official would be a "high risk" if he were to be placed in a position of authority over children he is familiar with.

On Feb. 6, Hanson pleaded guilty to one Class D felony count that accused him of fondling or touching a youth between August 1989 and February 1990. Brubaker accepted the guilty plea and set March 6 as Hanson's sentencing

A three-month investigation by the Howard County Sheriff Department led to the filing of charges against Hanson and Van-Tyle last summer. According to officers, the investigation was initiated by the attempted molestation of a 16-year-old boy.

The investigation revealed that two men had been involved in numerous incidents of child molestation involving 39 male victims, over a period of several

years, officers said.



Two former Roy Scout leaders from Russiaville face felony child molestation charges in Howard Circuit Court.

# 2 former scoutmasters charged in molestations

Two former Boy Scout leaders in Kokomo each have been charged with two counts of child molesting and are suspects in alleged molestations involving 35 other boys. Howard County sherif's investigators said Tuesday.

Warrants are expected to be issued today from Howard Superior Court for Thomas Vantyle. 25. of Russiaville and James Hanson, 46. of western Howard County.

Both men have admitted their involvement in 39 molestations of teen-age Scouts and non-Scouts, said Sheriff's Lt. Don Howard.

"They have both been cooperative in our investigation," Howard said.

The allegations, which date to 1978, surfaced in March when a youth reported a molestation attempt to his parents. However, the statute of limitations has run out on many of the allegations, and the Howard County prosecutor's office is expected to pursue only the two charges that each faces,

The charges against Hanson.

a factory employee, involve the molestations of youths not involved in Scouting. Vantyle, a restaurant employee, is charged with molesting one 15-year-old Scout after a troop meeting and molesting a 15-year-old non-Scout.

Hanson and Vantyle were, suspended from Scouting, in, June after allegations arose against them, said Dewey Long, finance director for the Boy Scouts of America Sagamore Council in Kokomo.

Hanson had served as scoutmaster for Troop 519 before passing those duties to his former assistant scoutmaster. Vantyle.

The troop now has about 20 members and none of those are believed to have been molested. Long said.

Counseling has been offered to the victims and their families through the Scouting program. Long said.

Also, the council has adopted a nationally used awareness program that involves a detailed questionnaire for potential leaders and offers ways to detect the potential for sexual abuse. Long said.
