Dear Ted:

Here is the form on George Weeks which Jim Robinson handed me at Denton Rotary on Tuesday night (by pre-arrangement - I was making up) and which I have completed.

I was in Denton today and procured photocopies of the District Court record which I append. (Proper name is the District Court of Maryland for Caroline County.) This indicates that there were two charges of child abuse and two charges of battery. A judgment of nolle prosequi (a dropping of charges) was entered in each child abuse case. Presumably, this was upon motion of the State's Attorney. On the battery cases the court entered probation before judgment. This means there is no conviction and no criminal record. The probation period is 30 months from May 18, 1987. One of the terms of probation is "no Scouting duties." I can not fully decipher the other term but it has to do with contribution for child welfare. If it becomes important to know this, let me know and I shall get it deciphered. The District Judge is L. Edgar Brown who was an associate in my law office when I went on the Court of Appeals in 1968. Of course, if Weeks were to violate the law in any respect during the period of his probation, the probation order could be stricken and he could be tried and sentenced.

The investigating officer was Sam Shelly who was, and I think still is, Scoutmaster at East New Market.

The incident in question is a regrettable one which, while a technical violation of law, was not a serious one. As I told you, Weeks contacted me immediately after it took place to apprise me of it. He expressed his regret at that time for any embarrassment it might cause Scouting. He continues as a friend of Scouting.


I have the Troop copy of the Weeks assistant scoutmaster application in the troop file and can send it up for copying if you cannot readily locate the Council copy.

The facts of the incident in question, as I understand them, are that when Troop 137 was camping at the troop campsite on the Laverne Bullock farm near Federalsburg George Weeks poked one boy with his foot to get him up and playfully put a dog on another boy. If you want more details, let me know or contact Trooper Shelly. I would have no hesitancy in talking with him personally. I also would have no hesitancy in asking Judge Brown as to just what came out in court. Bob Sweeney, the Chief Judge of the District Court, has told me that he regards Judge Brown, who travels over the State, as just about the best judge in the District Court system. He says he has had letters praising him from attorneys, litigants, and court personnel.

You may wish to append this letter to your report.

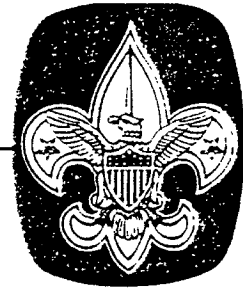
