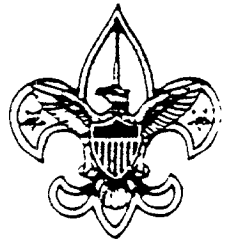



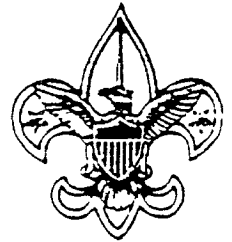

Dear Mr. White:

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted or reinstated. The procedure for review are attached.

Man pleads guilty in sex assault on teen

WAUPACA — Bradford A. White, 29, 310 Granite St., Waupaca, entered a guilty plea to a charge of fourth-degree sexual assault Monday in Waupaca County Circuit Court.

Judge John Hoffmann ordered counseling and one year probation for White.

White was originally charged with second-degree sexual assault, a felony, but the charge was re-

duced to fourth degree, a misdemeanor, in exchange for the guilty plea.

White was charged in an incident involving a 16-year-old male youth who was staying overnight at White's cottage sometime in June 1988. According to the complaint, White had a group of youths at his cottage drinking beer. The assault on one of the youths occurred after the youth had fallen asleep.

Sexual assault charge is lodged

WAUPACA — A 29-year-old Waupaca man was charged with second-degree sexual assault Thursday for an alleged assault on a 16-year-old youth in June of 1988.

Bradford A. White, 310 Granite St., Waupaca, appeared before Waupaca County Circuit Court Judge John Hoffman, who released White on a \$1,000 signature bond. Hoffman continued the initial appearance to Feb. 28 to give White time to confer with an attorney.

The alleged incident occurred be-

tween June 1 and June 30 while the youth was staying at White's cottage in the Town of Dayton.

The complaint states the victim, who was 15 years old at the time, was staying at White's cottage along with three other youths where they had been drinking. The complaint states that White assaulted the youth after he had dozed off.

The charge, a felony, carries a maximum penalty of 10 years in jail and a \$10,000 fine.
