SUBJ: Arrest of Centreville Scout Leader

Our office received a telephone call today from Sgt. O'Keefe of the Fairfax County Police Department (. . Ted Krisanda returned the call and provided the following information to me.

Sgt. O'Keefe reported to us the arrest of Mr. Henry Whitmer, Jr. Mr. Whitmer is currently registered as an Assistant Scoutmaster with Troop 893, sponsored by the Centreville United Methodist Church. Mr. Whitmer has been charged with "criminal solicitation" which Sgt. O'Keefe defined as soliciting sex from a minor. The following facts were provided by Sgt. O'Keefe.

- Arraignment on this charge occurred on 4/8/87.
- Mr. Whitmer met the boy through Scouting.
- The sexual acts, for which he is charged, did not occur during a Scouting event.
- There is currently no evidence to indicate the involvement of other minors.
- Since being charged, he has ceased activity with the troop.

I am providing this information to you since, in the past, our policy has been to suspend the individual's membership, pending the outcome of the charges.

Dear Mr. Davis:

This letter is in follow up to my telephone conversation with Bob Mersereau advising you that on April 7, 1987, Henry J. Whitmer, Jr. was charged with criminal solicitation to commit felony, Consentual Sodomy with a minor, a violation of Section 18.2-361 of the Virginia Code. The felony charge was amended to a misdemeanor, Sexual Battery, Section 18.674. On May 4, 1987, Mr. Whitmer was found guilty of the misdemeanor sexual battery charge and sentenced to twelve months in jail with twelve months suspended, and one year probation with mental health counseling to be monitored by the probation department.
