

CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS LEADING TO THE REQUEST FOR RESIGNATION OF LLOYD WILLOCK

District #2 Council #553 Unit # Troop 601 Position MC LDR #042184

- 1. An anonymous call was received in the Scout Service Center at approximately 11:00 p.m. on 8/23/87 by Senior District Executive Robert Scherini.
- 2. The lady calling stated that a friend of hers told her that aloya willock went on a camping trip the weekend of 3/20 with a group of Scouts.
- 3. The informant stated that the caller stated that she and her husband knew Lloyd Willock from Fort Jackson Military Base and that he had been arrested for child abuse at one time. She also understood that he was arrested in Lexington County about three years ago on similar charge.
- 4. The caller stated that she personally knew Lloyd and that he is not the kind of person that should be involved with youth.

Summary

Staff member Robert Scherini stated that the caller seemed very sincere and in his opinion was truthful and he had no reason to doubt the motive of the call.

On September 2nd, Jim Dalton called Paul Ernst, Director of Registration and Fulfillment Service. He was advised to request a resignation of Lloyd Willock directly through the Troop Committee and to submit the Confidential Record Sheet to the National Office.

This action has been taken at the time of this initial report. We will keep you informed as needed on the progress of this case in accordance with the Procedures for Maintaining Standards of Leadership.
