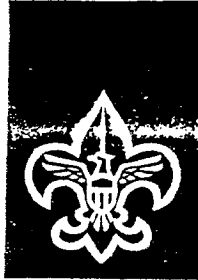

3:24 a.m./p.m. The State is represented by the above named Deputy County Attorney; the Defendant is present with above named counsel.

Court Reporter Lerryn Horton is present.

The defendant is advised of the charge, the determination of guilt and is given the opportunity to speak.

Pursuant to A.R.S. Section 13-607, the Court finds as follows:

- [] WAIVER OF COUNSEL The Defendant knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily waived his right to be represented by counsel after being advised of the right to be represented by counsel including the right to have counsel appointed free of charge if the Defendant is indigent.
- [] WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL The Defendant knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily waived his right to a trial by jury after having been advised of his right to same. The determination of guilt was based upon a trial to the Court.

OFFENSE: Attempted Sexual Abuse/Dangerous Crime Against Children in the Second Degree

FELONY CLASS: 3

IN VIOLATION OF A.R.S. SECTIONS: 13-1404, 13-1401, 13-604.01 G/K

DATE OF OFFENSE: April 1 through April 30, 1988

SENTENCE: The Defendant shall be placed on supervised probation for four (4) years. As a condition of probation, the Defendant shall be incarcerated at the Coconino County Jail for ninety (90) days. The family shall attend counseling through the Coconino Community Guidance Center or through a church counselor as long as the counselor is State certified. The Defendant shall secure the permission of the Adult Probation Officer for out-of-state travel. There will be no visitation between the Defendant and his daughter except under the supervision of the Arizona Department of Economic Security. The Defendant is authorized to be released from jail to attend any counseling sessions. The Defendant shall perform 100 hours of community service.

The Defendant is advised concerning his rights of appeal and written notice of those rights is provided.

Written Report: Harvey Dee Wright

Harvey has been accused and pled guilty to child molestation.

Harvey's daughter, [REDACTED], went to her religious leader and told him that her father was touching her. When the father was confronted he admitted that for a period of over two years at a rate of about three to four times a month he had been touching his daughter on her breasts and genital area. Both Harvey and [REDACTED] say that no incest took place.

Harvey was registered as a team committee member in Team 129. A letter (copied from Appendix B - Sexual Child Abuse) was delivered. The Council President and I reviewed council procedure with Harvey. Letter delivered August 29, 1988.
