Dear Charlie:

The eight individuals should be given letters indicating that the decision was supported to continue to deny membership. They should also be told how to apply for a national review should they require such. The individuals involved are: Darrell Bowen, Bradley Frymoyer, Terence Gorman, Bruce Hamblin, Donald Hubbard, Larry Pollock, James Thompson, and Ron Eicheldinger.

Michael Michalski should not be allowed to register since he has been put on probation for his actions. We have had a rather strong policy that no one on probation can be registered with the Boy Scouts of America. Once the probation is completed he can request an additional review to determine if registration should be granted at that time. This individual was from the Morris-Sussex Council in Denville, New Jersey.

We never allow an individual to be registered who is prohibited from having contact with all members of the Boy Scouts of America. We have found that we can not control this registration, and therefore, feel that we could not grant registration which would say adult contact only. This involves the case of Tom Rokita of the Thomas A. Edison Council, Edison, New Jersey. We, therefore, have to deny the reinstatement of this individual into a registered status. If he wishes to request a national review he can do so.

We will permit Gunnar Hartzsch of the Fairfield County Council in Norwalk, Connecticut to register on probation. We will maintain this file and follow up with the council to determine if there have been any further problems. The council, of course, has the option of refusing or denying registration when it is requested. You may send him a letter indicating that he will be able to register on probation upon council approval. I am assuming you will talk to the council before this letter is sent.
