You may recall that I have spoken to you on the telephone about my former scoutmaster, Charles Brinkman, and his sexual abuse of me and other scouts during 1961.

It has come to my attention that Mr. Brinkman was "caught" at sexual abuse sometime during 1963-1964, that he was banned from participation in the Boy Scouts of America for life, and that your office maintains a file on the case. I am relieved to know that he was caught and banned.

From the information on your file on Mr. Brinkman, please tell me whether or not he was confronted by the criminal justice system at the time he was "caught" by the Boy Scouts of America? In addition, if you have in your files his social security number please give it to me?

We have not been able to discover anyone registered with the Boy Scouts of America, at this time, with that name. We would, however, like a written statement from you, if you would do this for us, indicating what actually happened and as much information you can give us about the location and the individual.

We are relying on you for any information which we can secure, since we have not been able to find out anything else at this time from other individuals. We will, of course, keep alert to any information that might surface.

Dear "Skipper":

First let me thank you for the very nice note saying you had read Dick's letter and thought it was good.


I am enclosing in this letter two men's names we feel should go on the red flag list - the first and most important is Charles Brinkman who was a Scoutmaster for a number of years out in Lawrence and before that in another troop on the east side. It is probably the worse case of sodomy that I have run across. It affected at least sixteen boys we know of in two troops. He even used his [REDACTED], who is 6 years old, as a subject. As you will see in the attached letter he pleaded guilty to this charge in Criminal Court #2.

I am glad to say that because of a marvelous job done by Charles Merrick, our District Commissioner, the troop was saved. The parents were informed, the boys were shown a proper movie on effects, we had a psychiatrist talk to the parents and the boys, and now the troop has excellent leadership. The parents are behind the program, working harder than they ever did before.

I am sending you a copy of the letter received from our District Commissioner who handled this case as far as the unit was concerned. Under no circumstances should this man be allowed to be active in Scouting again.

Also, I am enclosing a copy of a letter telling about a man, Paul Hunt, who was picked up for shoplifting. We feel this man should be red flagged too.

This is to let you know that Mr. Brinkman pleaded guilty to the charge of Sodomy this date, 12-16-63, in Criminal Court #2, Marion County, before Judge Raub.

Sentencing is set for December 26th. The crime carries a sentence of 2-14 years. Sentencing is being delayed pending investigation and consultation with Dr. DeArmond, who has been treating Mr. Brinkman.

The guilty plea precludes any further concern as far as publicity is involved and no testimony was necessary by the boy or boys. It is good to know that the boys did not have to go through the trying experience of testifying.

You will want this information for submission to National Headquarters.
