Tues. July 22 or Wed. July 23 at D A Scout Camp after dark in the tent Larry was sleeping.

The occasion was [redacted]'s Second Class Scout Masters Conf. [redacted] and Mr. Dave Sawyer were alone in the tent. Mr. Sawyer had a flash light.

Mr. Sawyer asked [redacted] to take down his pants. He asked [redacted] if he wanted to and [redacted] said no. Mr. Sawyer said this was an initiation and insisted. Mr. Sawyer rubbed [redacted]'s penis and kissed it. Mr. Sawyer had his penis out and asked [redacted] to rub it and kiss it but [redacted] touched it and refused to do more.

Mr. Sawyer told [redacted] not to tell to keep it to themselves. When [redacted] returned to the cabin [redacted]'s father, noticed [redacted] looked upset and about ready to cry. He said nothing to [redacted] because he was afraid [redacted] would start crying. [redacted] assumed Mr. Sawyer had "bawled" [redacted] out about something.

Mr. [redacted] reported this incident to Mrs. [redacted] (that [redacted] was upset after his conference) when he (Mr. [redacted]) returned home on Thursday, July 24.

The reason this was revealed was [redacted] and Larry were talking about initiations and Larry told [redacted] this wasn't done. Mrs. [redacted] overheard and questioned [redacted] about what was wrong. [redacted] reluctantly told Mrs. [redacted] what had happened.

[redacted] was and is very upset about the possibility of Mr. Sawyer harming him because [redacted] had told us this.

Mr. [redacted] asked [redacted] if this is why he had been so upset that evening (July 22 or 23) and [redacted] said yes.
