We have mut with Mr. Votava and have secured his unconditional, immediate resignation from the Boy Scouts of America. We have also informed our National Personnel Division, so that his name can be entered in Scouting's confidential file, which will make it impossible for him to ever again affiliate with the Boy Scouts of America.

Because you, in sesence, brought the problem to us - we are not pursuing this situation further with the boy's parents, law enforcement agencies, his employer, etc. If this is done, it should be pursued by you.

Millions of volunteer leaders give continuing leadership to the boys and units active in the Boy Scoots of America and, unfortunately - we do occasionally encounter situations such as this.

Again, we express our deep appreciation to you.

Then about 6 months ago the contacts dropped off as the boy's Scouting activity lessened. the last contact occured a month ago when the boy visited the Scoutmaster for a letter of recommendations me his mouth on The basic nature of the act was that of the man usi the reproductive organ of the boy. These contacts took place in the man's basement The boy said he knew of at least one other Scout who was similarly related to the Scoutmaster, but would not give his name.
