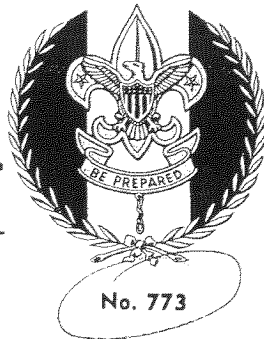

This is in response to your phone call of Friday afternoon concerning Troop 382 of Vernon, Connecticut. This troop was received in this office on January 4, 1966 and met all the requirements for registration except for the fact that the unit leader had to be questioned against the confidential file. The time that it took to obtain the needed information precluded the possibility of including Troop 382 as part of 1965 business from a membership and statistical point of view.

Unfortunately, the information you provided indicates that the unit leader is the same as one on whom we have information and whose registration we will be unable to accept, so we must continue to hold the unit pending until a replacement is obtained.

I am sorry that the fact that we will not be able to process this application prevented your staff member from receiving the recognition he apparently deserves for gains in membership in units this past year. I can only substantiate the fact that the unit was in this office in time and would have been processed except for the confidential file situation.

Before a general court-martial which convened at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, pursuant to Special Orders No. F-152, Headquarters, Air Proving Ground Center (ARDC), Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, dated 19 September 1960, was arraigned and tried:

AIRMAN SECOND CLASS RENE M. ST GERMAIN, AF 22 884 152, United States Air Force, 4135th Armament and Electronics Maintenance Squadron, 4135th Strategic Wing (Strategic Air Command), Eglin Air Force Base, Florida.

CHARGE: Violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 134.

Specification: In that AIRMAN SECOND CLASS RENE M. ST GERMAIN, U. S. Air Force, 4135th Armament and Electronics Maintenance Squadron (Strategic Air Command), did, at Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, on or about 28 June 1960, take indecent liberties with [REDACTED] a male under sixteen years of age, by causing him obscene literature to read and by placing his hand upon [REDACTED] private parts with intent to gratify the lust of the said AIRMAN SECOND CLASS RENE M. ST GERMAIN.

PLEAS: To the Charge and the Specification: NOT GUILTY

FINDINGS: Of the Specification and Charge: GUILTY

SENTENCE: To be discharged from the service with a Dishonorable Discharge; to forfeit all pay and allowances; to be confined at hard labor for four months and to be reduced to the grade of Airman Basic. (No previous convictions considered).

DATE ADJUDGED: The sentence was adjudged on 27 September 1960.

ACTION:

HEADQUARTERS, AIR PROVING GROUND CENTER, AIR RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT COMMAND, UNITED STATES AIR FORCE, EGLIN AIR FORCE BASE, FLORIDA, 13 October 1960

In the foregoing case of AIRMAN SECOND CLASS RENE M. ST. GERMAIN, AF 22 884 152, United States Air Force, 4135th Armament and Electronics Maintenance Squadron, 4135th Strategic Wing (Strategic Air Command), Eglin Air Force Base, Florida, only so much of the sentence as provides for bad conduct discharge, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, confinement at hard labor for four months, and reduction to the grade of airman basic is approved. The forfeitures shall apply to pay becoming due on and after the date of this action. The record of trial is forwarded to The Judge Advocate General of the United States Air Force for review by a board of review. Pending completion of appellate review, the accused will be confined in the Base Stockade, Eglin Air Force Base, Florida.
