STATEMENT REGARDING JACK BAXTER

On Monday, June 5th, I received a phone call from Pastor [REDACTED] of the Charles Street Presbyterian Church asking me if I was interested in an immoral act by one of our Scouters.

I assured him I was and he asked me to be present at his office the following day, June 6th at 2:30 to visit with the parents of the boy involved.

Present in his office were Mr. and Mrs. [REDACTED], whose son [REDACTED] belongs to Troop 16. The Assistant Scoutmaster, Jack Baxter has been overly friendly with their son and the father questioned the relationship.

The son implied that there were unusual events happening but was rather persistent that they were not immoral.

We asked the father to again visit with his son and if his son would not speak to him, to try to involve the Pastor of his church.

On Wednesday morning, June 7th, Rev. [REDACTED] of the New Milford Methodist Church called me and said he had a conversation with Jack Baxter during which he admitted having had immoral relationships with [REDACTED].

I called Mr. Baxter and he came to my office at 4:30 on June 7th, admitted the indecency, and signed a resignation statement. A report has been filed with the Confidential File of the Personnel Service.
