

CONFIDENTIAL REPORT on Bruce Ady

Oregon, called at our office on Monday, August 3, 1964, to report of his heresay evidence relative to Mr. Ady's Character.

That evening at the office he produced a line, la years of age, a student at Portland State College, who reported that on an outing at Eagle Creek he slept with Mr. Ady, who tried to play with his genital organs. Guy Miller was present during part of this conversation.

Mr. was informed the next morning. He advised I talk to Dr. Kreppaehn, 228-9181, a father of above in the present unit. He later reported back no evidence to substantiate.

Also contacted was Hal Worth, member of the troop committee, AT 4-3497, who after questioning his two boxs could find no supporting evidence. He guaranteed to make sure additional adult leadership would be present on the camping trip.

A Dr. Blarcomb, minister of First Methodist Church, was given the facts to date and promised he world be kept posted.

On Tuesday, August 1, I contacted a process, student at Lincoln High, who stated that Bruce had made three attempts at him: first while they were sleeping in the recreation room of Bruce Ady's fraternity house in Eugene; second while on a campout at Eagle Greek; and a third time when he was at Bruce's apartment.

I am now convinced that this man should be called in as soon following his trip with Troop No. 1 and given the opportunity to resign quietly. These stories could not be a fabrication because they come from divergent groups of people.

Again, reluctantly, I must request that the name of one of our Scouters be placed in the confidential file. This should have been done some time ago; but the pressure of time and the fact that the young man has stayed right here in Portland has made it a lower prority than some other items.

The man in question is Mr. Bruce Ady, registered until recently as the Scoutmaster of Troot. I, Portland Area Council, and for two or three years as Explorer Advisor of Explorer Post 1. The facts of our investigation are outlined in a report enclosed by and resulted in my calling Mr. Ady in, confronting him with the facts, and accepting his resistation from his Scouting responsibilities.

Since that time, the Army has made an investigation because of his involvement in the Reserve, and a short time ago the enclosed article appeared in the paper indicating his arrest. It is my understanding that he is about to come to trial, and I will forward the results of this following its completion. In the meantime if you will send us the sheet we will complete the necessary materials and return them to you. Dest wishes:
