The purpose of this letter is to document, per the request of the local scout office, my complaint to you about the conduct of Richard, also known to me as "R.B."


My son, complained to me about Richard "picking" on him during the troop's recent camping session at Cove Creek. In response to my questions, told me that Richard followed him to his tent and, when they were alone, put his hand under shirt. Told him he didn't like what he was doing, but Richard kept it up, telling him he should trust him. He rubbed back and pinched his nipple. When another boy walked up, left. He also complained that Richard had followed him to the shower and stood outside while he showered, suggesting that the let him hand him his soap and towel. Said that Richard stood outside the whole time he showered, but did not touch him. These are the only incidents of a sexual nature, but I consider them to be deviant behavior, outside the permissible range.

has a good understanding of sexual abuse issues, appropriate to his age. In questioning the property of the inject words or thoughts into his account of what actually happened. I am experienced in cross-examination. Although he was self-protective enough to handle the situations properly, was very troubled by the incidents. Richard had presented him with an award for being a high achiever at camp. When complained to two older boys in the troop about Richard "picking" on him, they told him that it wouldn't bother him when he was older. I did not tell them how Richard had "picked" on him, and he realizes now that they were not condoning Richard's behavior. I counselled him on how well he handled the situation,

and I praised his ability to act, based on his own knowledge and belief that what Richard was doing was wrong.

I consider Richard a threat to my son and Scouting. You have informed me that Richard is out of Troop 7 and Scouting--permanently. I think you have acted responsibly and taken appropriate precautions in light of your information on this person. Thank you for exercising your leadership skills and rewarding our trust in this difficult situation.



Dear Sir,

On the 20th of May, 1991, I observed Richard Bryant, an assistant Scoutmaster with Troop 7, sitting in a corner of the Scout Hut, with a scout sitting on his knee, with Richard's arm around the boy. I asked the scout to rejoin his patro, and I told Richard that we didn't need to put our hands on the boys. Richard mumbled something about it being alright, and he didn't mean anything by it. I told him, that I didn't want to see it again, and I later related the incident to Glenn Crowder, who is scoutmaster of the troop. This was not the first incident that I had noticed Richard, being what I considered overly friendly with the boys, and I had told Richard what I felt was the BSA policy about this matter.

I had heard that he had pinched a couple of the scouts on the rear while up at scout cammp, and I also noticed him again with his arm around several of the boys while up at camp.

On the 30th of June, after I had returned from an out of town trip, Glann Crowder, told me that he had a conservation with one of the parents of a boy that had been at camp, and how that child had been "touched" by Richard Bryant. The parent stated that either Richard was removed from the troop, or he would take his son out of the troop. As the Committee Chaairman, of Troop 7, and a concerned parent, I concure that Richard Bryant should be removed from the scouting program.


