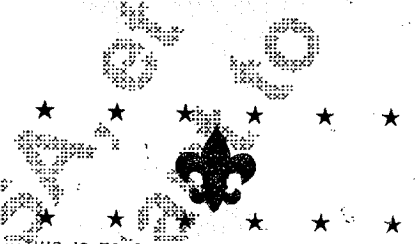

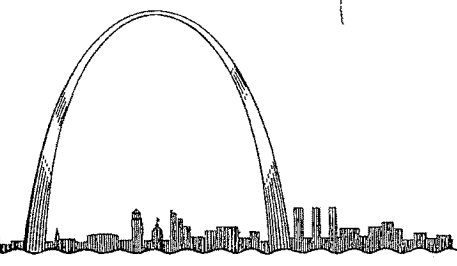

three years.

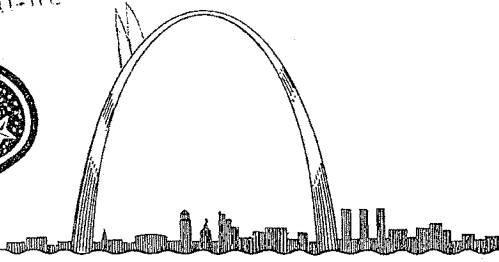
## Pope Paul Attends 1st Lenten Sermon


I trust you will share the contents of this letter with Jack Rhea.

At 12:32 a.m., on October 4, Major Trotter and the University City Police Force arrested Thomas Gold, when he was found nude from the waist down, masturbating between two apartment buildings, in University City, Missouri. Prior arrests include child molestation, sodomy, breaking and entering. He was currently on a two-year probation for these prior arrests.

It just proves you cannot be too careful, because here is a young man who worked three or four years at Philmont Scout Ranch and at Schiller Scout Reservation, and some six years ago was for one year on our camp staff. His whole family, specifically his father, has had a long and active association in Scouting with many achievements.
