### Dear Paul:

In response to your letter dated October 3, 1989, you will find enclosed a confidential, contemporaneous listing of events regarding the suspension of John\_F. Chapman. As you know, the letter we received was anonymous, but was compelling and illeged child molestation to children who have since reached adulthood. A copy of the anonymous letter was sent to you previously.

When a witnessing volunteer and I met with John Chapman, I mentioned to him that we had received a letter from an area where he had previously served as a volunteer, making allegations serious enough that would require the Boy Scouts of America to suspend his membership. We were extremely careful not to discuss the anonymity, origin, the timeframe, nor specifically the allegations. Paul, we felt the anonimity of the accuser could have caused some legal complications if disclosed, therefore, we had to exercise extreme caution.

Upon his learning about his suspension, Mr. Chapman began to sulk and weep. He attempted to justify the allegations with the following facts:

\*John Chapman was a career enlisted person in the U.S. Air Force stationed in Florida prior to moving to Liberty, South Carolina where he enrolled his son in Scouting and became an Assistant Scoutmaster.

\*John Chapman and his cousin, an inexperienced electrician, were stationed at the same Air Force Base.

\*John Chapman's cousin was assigned to complete an electrical assignment on a building that would require someone with more experience.

\*His cousin protested the complexity of the job but was ordered by his superivsors to complete the work.

\*John Chapman's cousin was electrocuted and sustained serious burns, but survived.

\*John Chapman persisted that an inquiry into the accident be conducted and even contacted Senator Strom Thurmond which eventually led to the early retirement of several of his cousin's supervisors.

\*According to John Chapman, these people were seeking revenge, thus the allegations.

At this point I discussed the appeliate procedures with John Chapman and mentioned that following a thorough investigation into the allegations a decision would be made as to whether or not he could be reinstated if he so desired. His response was, "I don't want to lose my children", and he requested that an investigation not be conducted. The volunteer with me mentioned to Mr. Chapman that if he felt strongly that the allegations were untrue, that he should appeal in order to resolve the matter. But, Mr. Chapman insisted that no investigation be held. He chose to surrender voluntarily his membership card and severe all ties with Scouting. He and his son have since discontinued meeting with the Troop.

Paul, John Chapman's story appeared initially to have some credibility. However, his defense was an incident that occurred in Florida where he lived just prior to his retirement from the Air Force. The anonymous letter contained allegations when he lived in Ohio and Morrocco which occurred prior to his moving to Florida. Next, when he mentioned that he did not want to lose his children was it because of threats of loss of custody during earlier investigations as the anonymous letter suggested?

I hope this information will suffice in resolving this case, but if you need more information please let me know. I will be pleased to assist you.



August 28, 1989 - T/C Paul Ernst @ National Office for reassurance re. procedures to follow when letter is received from anonymous accuser alleging child abuse. Paul Ernst confirmed that membership should be suspended and an internal investigation should be conducted to document allegations.

August 28-29,89 - Prepared letter re. suspension of John Chapman to be signed by Council President, John Kincaid. T/C Tuffy Sargent re. schedule appointment to duscuss a highly confidential matter that affects T172. Asked Sargent to maintain absolute confidentiality.

August 30, 1989 - Mtg. Tuffy Sargent, SM, T172, to ask if suspicion ever existed re. John Chapman, SA, T172 for child molestation. Discussed allegations and asked for absolute confidentiality.

Sept. 1, 1989 - Letter received endorsed by Council President.

September 15, 1989 - At District Committee discussion that new Troop being organized with John Chapman as SM. Mentioned by Tuffy Sargent that new leader would be necessary with no discussion as to reasons.

Sept. 6, 1989 - T/C Jerry Bowen re. record of past problems with John Chapman as his application indicated service as SM in Gulf Coast Council. Said he would investigate and contact me.

Sept. 6, 1989 - T.C Tuffy Sargent to see if he would meet with John Chapman and me re. allegations. T/C John Chapman to schedule appointment for 5:30 p.m., Friday, September 8, 1989 in Liberty at Scout Hut 172.

Sept. 7, 1989 - Received call from Cheryl Clark, Registrar, Gulf Coast Council and was told that no record existed on John Chapman as a SM or district committee member in Council as per application indicated.

Sept. 8, 1989- Tuffy Sargent and Irby Small met with John Chapman to deliver letter suspending membership. No mention was made re. specific allegations but rather he was told a letter was received making serious allegations that require us to suspend membership. In response, Chapman mentioned the allegations were smear tactics from people in the military out to get even because of a congressional investigation he instigated at his base. However, it is worth noting that the defense he uses occurred after the alleged incidents that warranted his suspension. He asked that no further investigation be conducted and resigned without incident. His membership card was returned.

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations you may have with the Boy Scouts of America. A refund of your registration fee is enclosed.

You should understand that BSA membership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of membership the BSA seeks to provide for American youth.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me within 60 days of the date of this letter, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA member should be granted or reinstated. The procedures for review are attached.
