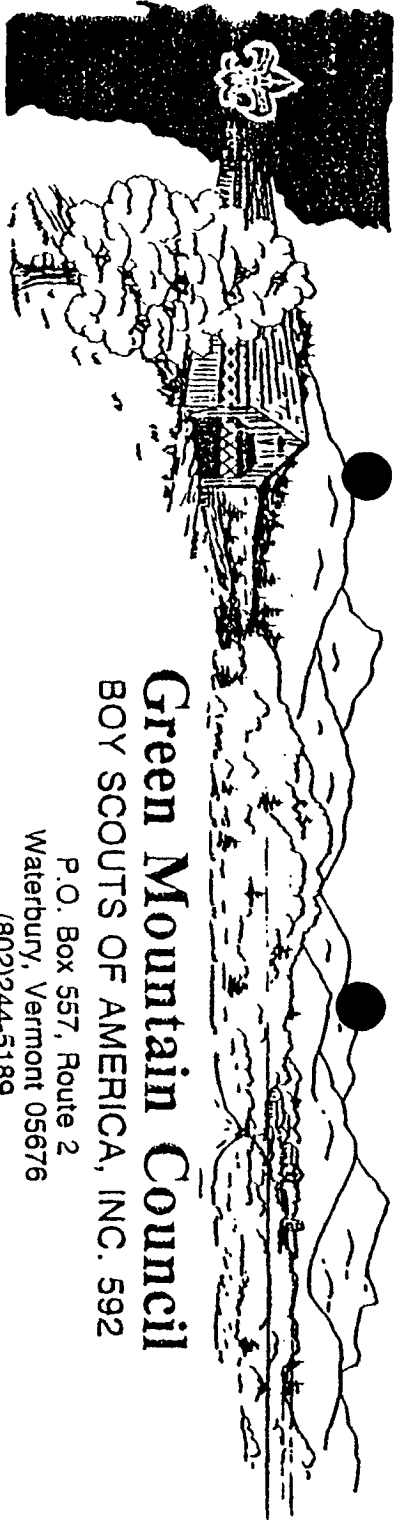

On Sunday June 9, 1991 at approximately 11:51 hours, [redacted] date of birth [redacted] and his mother [redacted] came to the Barre City Police Department. [redacted] wanted to make a complaint against Donald Codling, date of birth 02-18-38. [redacted] gave a taped and written statement.

[redacted] advised he has known Mr. Codling, for years, as [redacted] is a member of the Explorers at the Barre City Fire Department. [redacted] advised that Mr. Codling is a Captain at the Barre City Fire Department and is in charge of the Explorers.

[redacted] advised that on Thursday, June 6, 1991 he spent the night at Mr. Codling's residence of [redacted] in Barre, Vermont. [redacted] advised he spent the night because early on Friday morning, June 7, 1991 the Explorers were going to help the Barre City Ambulance with a mock plane crash, for training. [redacted] stated that since Mr. Codling was going to give him a ride to training that it would be easier to stay the night and leave with him.

[redacted] advised he stayed the night and then went to the training with Mr. Codling. He advised that after the training he went to Mr. Codling residence and showered and was driven home by Mr. Codling.

[redacted] advised that he returned to the Codling residence on the Friday evening, June 7th, 1991. He advised he had forgotten his Nintendo tape (Contra) and his class ring at the residence.

[redacted] advised that shortly after his arrival at approximately 19:15 hours, Mr. Codling asked him if he wanted to ride to Plainfield, Vermont to drop Mr. Codling's daughter [redacted] and her friend [redacted] off at [redacted] house in Plainfield. [redacted] advised he called his mother for permission and then agreed to go as Mr. Codling told him he could drive back.

[redacted] advised they left at approximately 20:00 hours. [redacted] advised he drove back on the Plainfield road by the Barre City Reservoir in Orange, Vermont onto Route 302. [redacted] advised that he was driving West on Route 302 and approximately two miles East of Rolands Mini Mart in East Barre, Vermont, Mr. Codling reached over and started grabbing his right knee and Mr. Codling moved his hand up [redacted] leg to his pelvis.

[redacted] advised he got very nervous and drove into the other lane and shifted into the wrong gear while shifting Mr. Codling's black standard shift pickup truck. [redacted] advised he drove to [redacted] the Codling residence and he and Mr. Codling went inside.

[redacted] advised they returned to residence at approximately 20:45 hours. [redacted] advised he told Mr. Codling that he wanted to go home and Mr. Codling advised him that he would take him home after he found out what his son [redacted] was going to do. Subscribed and sworn to before me on

[redacted] advised that he and Mr. Codling were alone in the house and that Mr. Codling went into the kitchen and told him he could play Nintendo in the living room. [redacted] advised he was playing Nintendo when Mr. Codling came back into the living room and began to hug and kiss him and rub his buttocks. [redacted] advised Mr. Codling put his tongue into his mouth and asked [redacted] to do it back, French kiss him. [redacted] advised he locked his jaw so Mr. Codling couldn't French kiss and told Mr. Codling that he didn't do that kind of thing, meaning he only French kissed girls.

[redacted] advised a car door slammed outside at approximately 20:55 or 21:00 hours and Mr. Codling went and looked out the window. [redacted] advised Mr. Codling's [redacted] came into the house with two friends. [redacted] advised he asked [redacted] and [redacted] friends for a ride home several times and when they left at 21:05 hours he asked again. [redacted] advised that Mr. Codling said he would give [redacted] a ride and [redacted] said as he left "Ducky will give you a ride home."

[redacted] advised that after [redacted] left that Mr. Codling grabbed him by the wrist, pulled him out of a chair and started to hug him and rub his hand on [redacted] buttocks. [redacted] advised Mr. Codling brought his hand to the front of [redacted] sweat pants and began playing with [redacted] penis on the outside of [redacted] pants and then put his hand inside [redacted] pants and played with [redacted] penis.

[redacted] advised that Mr. Codling told him how big his penis was and asked [redacted] to touch Mr. Codling's penis. [redacted] said Mr. Codling, holding onto [redacted] arm, put [redacted] hand against Mr. Codling's penis on the outside of his pants.

[redacted] advised that he was very scared. [redacted] advised he couldn't leave as Mr. Codling was between he and the door. [redacted] advised he tried to grab his jacket and leave but couldn't Mr. Codling was holding onto his wrist. [redacted] advised he was scared and intimidated by Mr. Codling's large build. [redacted] advised that he repeatedly asked to go home and lied to Mr. Codling advising him he had to go home and take some Asthma medication before he had an attack.

[redacted] advised that Mr. Codling finally brought him home between 21:30 and 21:45 hours, date. [redacted] advised that that night after returning home, he went to [redacted] and told Debbie and Ernie Vasseur what Mr. Codling had done. [redacted] also advised that on Sunday, June 9th, 1991, before coming to the Barre City Police Department, he told Barre City Fire Chief Tom Venner what happened.

On Monday, June 10, 1991 I took written statements from Chief Venner and Ernie Vasseur. The explanation of what Mr. Codling did is the same in Venner's and Vasseur's statement as what [redacted] had told me.

On Monday June 10, 1991 at approximately 08:15 hours I went to the Barre City Subscribed and sworn to before me on 2

Fire Department on South Main Street in Barre, Vermont. Mr. Codling agreed to talk to me and we went into Chief Venners unoccupied office to talk.

Mr. Codling advised me that on Friday night June 7, 1991, [redacted] had come to his house and had ridden to Plainfield with him to drop off [redacted] and her friend. He advised that [redacted] did drive his truck back to Barre as he drives his truck quite often. Mr. Codling denied that anything happened in the truck, stating that he didn't touch [redacted] at all.

Mr. Codling advised that after they returned to his residence he and [redacted] were alone in the house and were in the living room. Mr. Codling advised that [redacted] was upset and was asking several sexual questions, feeling that he was not like other guys and that his penis was too small.

Mr. Codling advised he gave [redacted] a hug and put his hand inside [redacted] pants and felt [redacted] penis. He advised he did this so he could tell [redacted] he was normal size.

Mr. Codling also said that [redacted] touched his penis on the outside of his pants once. Mr. Codling also said [redacted] was very friendly and always was hugging the guys at the fire station.

Chief Venner advised me that he had never seen [redacted] hug anyone at the Fire station. Chief Venner did advise that [redacted] came into the Fire station alot and quite often with his girlfriend.

Mr. Codling also stated that [redacted] did ask to go home several times and stated that [redacted] said he was having an asthma attack and wanted to go home. Mr. Codling advised he did not hold [redacted] wrist, but advised he was hugging and holding [redacted].

I left the firestation at approximately 08:45 hours, date. I returned and reinterviewed Mr. Codling at approximately 09:00 hours, date. Mr. Codling advised that it was his idea to put his hands on [redacted] penis. Mr. Codling said to me "I should have backed off, but I didn't." Mr. Codling also advised that he and [redacted] pinched and tickled each others knees all the time. Mr. Codling also advised that [redacted] did ask to leave several times.

In both interviews Mr. Codling advised he felt bad about what he did and knew it was wrong. Mr. Codling even advised he thought he should have taken [redacted] to the Police Department to talk about it Friday night June 7, 1991. Mr. Codling also advised he thought he needed counseling and asked me to find a name and phone numbers of a good counselor. I did give him a list of five counselors and phone numbers.

Mr. Codling also advised me that eight or ten years ago he had molested a [redacted] they were watching, but that it was not investigated. Mr. Codlings wife [redacted]

City Firefighter Charged In Youth Sexual Offense

BARRE — A Barre City firefighter pleaded innocent to juvenile charges that involved a 17-year-old junior firefighter.

Donald Codling, 53, of Barre has since resigned his position with the Barre City Fire Department and the junior firefighter program has been temporarily discontinued.

Codling is charged with fondling the youth and allegedly refused the firefighter's request to take the youth to his parent's home Friday.

The youth is a member of the Explorers, a fire department sponsored organization that introduces young people to firefighting techniques. The youth was in Codling's care following a training exercise, according to court records.

Codling, who was a captain in the Barre City Fire Department, allegedly brought the youth to his home, kissed the boy, told police he couldn't leave Codling's home because Codling was blocking the door. Codling allegedly attempted to get the boy to touch his hand in the boy's pants and attempted to get the boy to touch his private parts, court records state.

When contacted at home, Tuesday, Codling had no comment on the case and said he has not yet hired an attorney.

Codling was released on conditional bond, including that he not be with children under the age of 16, except his daughter. He is also not allowed to associate with the alleged victim, according to the court. Meanwhile, the boy reported being scared. He told police he couldn't leave Codling's home because Codling was blocking the door. Codling allegedly held his wrist when the boy attempted to leave and the boy said

he was intimidated by Codling's large build.

Court records, which relate an interview between Codling and arresting Barre city police officer W. Samuel Hill, state that Codling said he had adopted two foster children he and his wife were responsible for eight or 10 years ago, but the case was not investigated.

Codling allegedly asked Hill for the name and phone number of a good counselor, saying he needed counseling.
