





Scoutmaster charged with sexual battery

Court appearance
today for Blount man

From staff reports

HUNTSVILLE, Tenn. — The scoutmaster of a Blount County Boy Scout troop was charged with aggravated sexual battery of a boy younger than 13 years old, Scott County District Attorney General Paul Phillips said Thursday.

Thomas R. Cox, 46, of the Twelve Oaks Subdivision in Maryville was charged in connection with an offense that allegedly

occurred during a campout at Big South Fork National Scenic and Recreational Area in Scott County Oct. 7 and 8.

Cox is to appear in Scott County General Sessions Court today.

Phillips said Cox has been a scoutmaster since 1986 and that the investigation is continuing.

He said investigators from the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, the Scott County Sheriff's Department and the Department of Human Services began looking into the incident at the campout after the victim talked with his parents.
