This primarily came about due to charges which were brought against him regarding sexual molestation with Steve felt this was coming and it came as no surprise to him. also given the procedures for a hearing if he so desired.

Dusty told me at that time that the situation had gotten worse and that four additional charges had been lodged against Steve; sexual molestation of a boy, sexual molestation with a babysitter, sexual molestation with forgery. Dusty has offered to furnish me with a copy of the charges and court proceedings which will be included with this statement.

The above-entitled cause came on regularly before the Court on the 11th day of July, 1990, upon the filing of an Information by Robert L. Deschamps III, Missoula County Attorney, accusing the Defendant of the crime of SEXUAL ASSAULT, a Felony, as specified in Section 45-5-502, U.C.A.

Whereupon the Information and Defendant's Maiver of Preliminary Examination having been filed, and the Defendant being informed of all of his legal rights, he was duly arraigned, answered to his true name and the reading of the Information was valved.

The Defendant was represented by councel, John Smith, at

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all stages of these proceedings.

Thereafter an Amended Information was filed accusing the Defendant of the crimes of Count I, II and III; SEXUAL ACCAULT, a Felony, as specified in Section 45-5-502, N.C.A.

On the 5th day of September, 1990, the Cofondant entered a plea of Not Guilty to all three counts.

Thereafter on the 21st day of March, 1991, a jury trial was held wherein the Defendant was found GUILTY on Count I and MOT GUILTY on Count II as charged in the Amended Information. The jury could not reach a verdict on Count III in the Amended Information as to guilt or innocence.

Thereafter the State made a notion to dismiss Count FLT and the Court granted such motion.

IT IS ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant is quilty of the offense charged.

IT IS THE JUDGHERT OF THE COURT that STUPHER DALK CRUIT be and STEPHER DALE CRIST is hereby sentenced to a horm of twenty (20) years in the Hontana State Prison in Deer Lodge, Hontana.

It is the recommendation of the Court that prior to eligibility for parole that the Defendant shall successfully complete the sex offender program at the Nontana State Prizer.

That, however, upon successful completion of the sex offender program the Defendant's sentence is hereby suspended on the terms and conditions listed below.

The terms and conditions of probation are as follows:

1. That the Court retains jurisdiction and the right to impose additional conditions;

- 3. That during the period of suspension of this Defendant shall remain under jurisdiction of this Court and of the Department of Institutions, Division of Adult Parole and Probation of the State of Montana, and the Dofondant shall be and is subject to all the rules and regulations of said department. In the event the Defendant breaches any of the rules of said department or violates any laws of this State or any other states or the Federal Government, he shall be subject to immediate arrest and thereupon brought before this Court to determine if this Court should revoke the suspension of this sentence as in the judgment of this Court which will then seem proper, lawful and just;
- 4. That the Defendant shall submit himself, his vehicle and his residence to search at any time by lawful authorities upon reasonable request of his Probation Officer.
- 5. That the Defendant shall not onter any establishment whose primary source of business is the sale of alcoholic beverages, except for employment purposes.
- 6. That the Defendant shall not drink any alcoholic beverages.
- 7. That the Defendant shall obtain a chemical dependency evaluation at the Defendant's own expense and participate in counseling as recommended.
- 8. That the Defendant shall submit to blood, breath, and urine testing for the detection of alcohol and/or drugs upon the request of his Probation Officer.
- 9. That the Defendant shall obtain any counseling at Defendant's own expense requested by his Probation Officer.
- 11. That the Defendant shall not have any contact

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with any person under the age of 18 years, unless permitted by his Probation Officer.

- 12. That the Defendant shall successfully complete the SABER Program under Dr. Scolatti, as directed by his Probation Officer.
- 13. That the Defendant shall make restitution through the Clerk of the District Court in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), and any other expense that may arise in regard to this offense, according to a schedule as set by his Probation Officer.
- 14. That the Defendant shall pay a fee through the Clerk of the District Court in the amount of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00), according to a schoolule as set by his Probation Officer, to go to the County Atterney Surcharge Fund as provided in Section 46-18-236, M.C.A.
- 15. That the Defendant shall pay the cost of prosecution through the Clark of the District Court in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), according to a schedule as set by his Probation Officer.
- 16. That the Defendant shall pay for this court appointed attorney through the Clerk of the District court in the amount of Eleven Thousand Three Burdred Thirty-five Dollars (\$11,335.00), according to a schedule as set by his Probation Officer.

Reasons for sentence and designation under Section 46-18-404 MCA are:

- 1. Defendant's criminal history;
- 2. Nature of the offense;
- 3. Defendant has been able to talk his way out of his problems in the past but now must be held accountable for conduct.




