S T A T E M E N T

On the morning of September 20, 1990 Jack Piippo, Mullan Trail District Chairman, and myself met with Mr. Steve Crist to serve him with an official letter revoking his registration. This primarily came about due to charges which were brought against him regarding sexual molestation with [REDACTED]. Steve felt this was coming and it came as no surprise to him. He was also given the procedures for a hearing if he so desired.

Upon arrival back at my office, I called Dusty Deschamps, Missoula County Attorney, to secure some needed information so we could get it back to the national office for their confidential records. Dusty told me at that time that the situation had gotten worse and that four additional charges had been lodged against Steve; sexual molestation of a boy, sexual molestation with a babysitter, sexual molestation with [REDACTED], and forgery. Dusty has offered to furnish me with a copy of the charges and court proceedings which will be included with this statement.

Codes on the attached file card and marked in red are as follows:

- V = victim
- S = suspect
- C = complainant
- A = arrested

To date he has no convictions. His trial will come up in October or November 1990 on the charges of 3 counts of sexual assault (felonies) and one count of misdemeanor forgery. The charges of such are attached and NCIC has nothing on him.

The above-entitled cause came on regularly before the Court on the 11th day of July, 1990, upon the filing of an Information by Robert L. Deschamps III, Missoula County Attorney, accusing the Defendant of the crime of SEXUAL ASSAULT, a Felony, as specified in Section 45-5-502, M.C.A.

Whereupon the Information and Defendant's Waiver of Preliminary Examination having been filed, and the Defendant being informed of all of his legal rights, he was duly arraigned, answered to his true name and the reading of the Information was waived.

The Defendant was represented by counsel, John Smith, at

1 all stages of these proceedings.

2 Thereafter an Amended Information was filed accusing the
3 Defendant of the crimes of Count I, II and III: SEXUAL ASSAULT,
4 a Felony, as specified in Section 45-5-502, M.C.A.

5 On the 5th day of September, 1990, the Defendant entered a
6 plea of Not Guilty to all three counts.

7 Thereafter on the 21st day of March, 1991, a jury trial was
8 held wherein the Defendant was found GUILTY on Count I and NOT
9 GUILTY on Count II as charged in the Amended Information. The
10 jury could not reach a verdict on Count III in the Amended
11 Information as to guilt or innocence.

12 Thereafter the State made a motion to dismiss Count III and
13 the Court granted such motion.

14 IT IS ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant is guilty of
15 the offense charged.

16 IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THE COURT that STEPHEN DALE CRIST be
17 and STEPHEN DALE CRIST is hereby sentenced to a term of twenty
18 (20) years in the Montana State Prison in Deer Lodge, Montana.

19 It is the recommendation of the Court that prior to
20 eligibility for parole that the Defendant shall successfully
21 complete the sex offender program at the Montana State Prison.

22 That, however, upon successful completion of the sex
23 offender program the Defendant's sentence is hereby suspended on
24 the terms and conditions listed below.

25 The terms and conditions of probation are as follows:

- 26 1. That the Court retains jurisdiction and the right
to impose additional conditions;

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2 2. That the Defendant shall never knowingly at any
3 time during the period of suspension, engage in any
4 conduct whatsoever offensive to the laws of the State
5 of Montana, any other states or any of the laws of the
6 United States of America, and conduct himself as a
7 good citizen at all times;

8 3. That during the period of suspension of this
9 sentence the Defendant shall remain under the
10 jurisdiction of this Court and of the Department of
11 Institutions, Division of Adult Parole and Probation,
12 of the State of Montana, and the Defendant shall be
13 and is subject to all the rules and regulations of
14 said department. In the event the Defendant breaches
15 any of the rules of said department or violates any
16 laws of this State or any other states or the Federal
17 Government, he shall be subject to immediate arrest
18 and thereupon brought before this Court to determine
19 if this Court should revoke the suspension of this
20 sentence as in the judgment of this Court which will
21 then seem proper, lawful and just;

22 4. That the Defendant shall submit himself, his
23 vehicle and his residence to search at any time by
24 lawful authorities upon reasonable request of his
25 Probation Officer.

26 5. That the Defendant shall not enter any
establishment whose primary source of business is the
sale of alcoholic beverages, except for employment
purposes.

6. That the Defendant shall not drink any alcoholic
beverages.

7. That the Defendant shall obtain a chemical
dependency evaluation at the Defendant's own expense
and participate in counseling as recommended.

8. That the Defendant shall submit to blood, breath,
and urine testing for the detection of alcohol and/or
drugs upon the request of his Probation Officer.

9. That the Defendant shall obtain any counseling at
Defendant's own expense requested by his Probation
Officer.

10. That the Defendant shall not have any contact
with the victims, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

11. That the Defendant shall not have any contact

1 with any person under the age of 18 years, unless
2 permitted by his Probation Officer.

3 12. That the Defendant shall successfully complete
4 the SABER Program under Dr. Scolatti, as directed by
5 his Probation Officer.

6 13. That the Defendant shall make restitution through
7 the Clerk of the District Court in the amount of One
8 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00), and any other expense
9 that may arise in regard to this offense, according to
10 a schedule as set by his Probation Officer.

11 14. That the Defendant shall pay a fee through the
12 Clerk of the District Court in the amount of Twenty
13 Dollars (\$20.00), according to a schedule as set by
14 his Probation Officer, to go to the County Attorney
15 Surcharge Fund as provided in Section 46-18-226,
16 M.C.A.

17 15. That the Defendant shall pay the cost of
18 prosecution through the Clerk of the District Court
19 in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars
20 (\$2,500.00), according to a schedule as set by his
21 Probation Officer.

22 16. That the Defendant shall pay for this court
23 appointed attorney through the Clerk of the District
24 court in the amount of Eleven Thousand Three Hundred
25 Thirty-five Dollars (\$11,335.00), according to a
26 schedule as set by his Probation Officer.

Reasons for sentence and designation under Section

46-18-404 MCA are:

1. Defendant's criminal history;
2. Nature of the offense;
3. Defendant has been able to talk his way out of his problems in the past but now must be held accountable for conduct.

Defendant shall receive credit for time served at Missoula County Jail for June 22, 1990, and for September 5, 1990, in the amount of two (2) days.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that as restitution in this matter is received by the Clerk of Court, the Clerk may pro rate partial

1 payments to the victim. The restitution shall be disbursed to
2 Crime Victims Compensation, Room 463, Scott Hart Bldg., 303
3 Roberts, Helena, MT 59620, in the amount of One Hundred Fifty
4 Dollars (\$150.00).

5 The Defendant is remanded to the custody of the Missoula
6 County Sheriff for transportation to Montana State Prison in
7 Deer Lodge, Montana, for execution of this sentence and
8 Judgment.

9 Appeal bond is hereby set at \$25,000.00.
