Dear Mr. Wheatcroft.

after careful consideration I have decided that I would like to have my registration, as an adult leader, with the Boy Scouts of America reinstated. This does not mean that, if I am reinstated, I will be as active in scouting as I used to be. That will take some time, however if so inclined, I would like to have that option available to me.

I understand that BSA leadership is a privilege and that is one privilege which I have not abused. I have dedicated my life to teaching and guiding the younger and weaker. I have never taken advantage of them in any way, shape, or form!

When you review my case please consider the following. Accusations should not be considered as proof of guilt or innocence. They are only accusations and nothing else.

I do ~~not~~ not know what 'facts' were presented to you.

Everything that I did on the weekend of October 12, had good solid legal and, more importantly, moral justifications. Remember that it is possible for, what would appear to be, unusual events to have equally unusual circumstances which justify them.

Finally the case against me was dismissed from court on the 14th of March. This alone should convince you of my innocence.

Now there are some points which I would like you to shed some light upon.

I was arrested, booked in jail, charged and released on bond one day before I received your letter. You know about the charges and acted upon them before I was made aware of them myself. To me that does not seem quite proper.

I have read that Fink was also banned from scouting for similar charges. Were your reasons for my suspension kept as equally confidential as the reasons for his? If so your Department of Confidentiality has some massive leaks.

I understand that there were legal obligations for banning me from scouting. I would have felt more comfortable with your letter if you had mentioned those obligations and let it go at that.

Instead you implied in your letter that I "may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth". To me that suggests that you made a judgement upon and against my moral character.

There is only one being in all of creation that I allow to have that privilege and you certainly are not him.

Please understand that I have no feelings of hatred, anger or animosity of any type directed towards scouting. I still regard scouting with a great deal of respect and admiration for its goals and high ideas.

I request that your review of my case be as swift and thorough as possible and then notify me of your decision.

After careful review, we have decided that your registration with the Boy Scouts of America should be suspended. We are therefore compelled to request that you sever any relations that you may have with the Boy Scouts of America.

You should understand that BSA leadership registration is a privilege and is not automatically granted to everyone who applies. We reserve the right to suspend registration whenever there is a concern that an individual may not measure up to the high standards of leadership which the BSA seeks to provide for American youth. Please also understand that this decision and the reasons for it will be maintained as confidential.

If you wish to have this decision reviewed, please write to me, explaining your version of the facts supporting your claim that your registration as a BSA leader should be granted or reinstated.

This memorandum is the result of Mark Jorn's calling Gail Gretlein asking for Dan Wheatcroft to look into a possible situation involving a youth and an adult leader. I could not reach Mark so I called Sister Carleen at Lakemary Center in Paola. She is the district training chairman and is the principal of the school which sponsors Troop 107. Sister Carleen's phone number is: [REDACTED]. Mark Jorn's phone number is [REDACTED].

Sister Carleen reported to me that it had been discovered that an alleged act of child abuse had taken place at the Council Extravaganza on Saturday night, October 12, 1985. An adult leader is reported to have molested a boy in his sleeping bag. I have not received the boy's name, his age is 12, the leaders name that is alleged to have committed this act is L. Z. Drummond, age 25, Scouting Coordinator and a committee member of Troop 107 and also listed as an Assistant Scoutmaster, Troop 105. Also a member of the Naish Camp Staff and possibly the Rotary Camp Staff. He is also listed as a Merit Badge Counselor.

At 1:00 PM on Wednesday, October 16, the school was to notify the SRS Agency which is the Social Referral Services Agency of the State of Kansas, to report the incident. This young man is a ward of the State of Kansas. Sister Carleen can give more information, including the boys name and how the individual was identified as having acted in such a manner at the Extravaganza. She was also interested in knowing what action the Boy Scouts would take at the present time to keep this individual from being near Boy Scouts.

IT WAS BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION BY ASSISTANT SCOUT MASTER, MIKE GABBERT, THAT L.Z. DRUMMOND HAD COME TO HIM WITH THE COMMENT: "IT WAS SO COOL LAST NIGHT, CHRIS DID NOT HAVE A SLEEPING BAG, I PUT HIM IN MY SLEEPING BAG."

MIKE MADE ANOTHER OBSERVATION, THAT L.Z. SEEMED TO BE TAKING THE BOYS TO THE PORTABLE BATHROOMS, IN AN ODD MANNER OF CONCERN, SPECIAL ATTENTION BEING GIVEN TO CHRIS WHO SUPPOSEDLY WOULD NOT USE THE UNITS BECAUSE HE WAS AFRAID OF THE DARK. L.Z. PERSONALLY TOLD ME THAT HE GOT HIM OVER THIS FEAR BY GOING INTO THE UNIT WITH HIM.

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
