On Monday, June 3, 1991 I received a call from the Douglas County Sheriff's Office and Special Investigations Officer Sam Christiansen (Officer Christiansen shared . with me an incident which occurred on Saturday, June 1, 1991 at approximately 9:00-9:30 P.M. in the vicinity of A young male (16 years of age, slight build of 5'6", 122 lbs., and apparently alone) was approached by Larry Fiehn. He attempted to pick the boy up and encouraged him to get into his car, and suggested that he would drive him to some location, etc. The boy was frightened, and when he got away from Mr. Fiehn called 911 and reported the incident as an attempted abduction. The police responded to the call and stopped Larry Fiehn's car. Fiehn told the story of how he was just trying to help the boy. The police conducted a search of Mr. Fiehn's vehicle at the time and among other materials that were in the car were found a copy of a Penthouse magazine, a bag of candy, (2) tubes of K-Y Jelly, and an opened box of condoms, all of which heightened the suspicion of arresting officers. Mr. Fiehn was released at the time and the Sheriff's Department opened an investigation.

MEMO

In the course of that investigation they discovered that Mr. Fiehn had a record going back to 1983. Sheriff Christiansen shared the contents of the police report and felt that the contents were of public knowledge. Apparently in 1983, Larry Fiehn was staying at a hotel in the vicinity of At approximately 11:00 P.M., a young male teenager who found himself disorientated was in a hall looking for his own room. Larry Fiehn came upon the boy and offered to help him find his way back to his room and suggested that they return to his (Fiehn's) hotel room where he had a map of the hotel. The boy went with Larry Fiehn to his room. It's reported that Fiehn offered the boy beer and invited him to stay in his room for the evening. The boy became frightened and tried to leave.

According to the boy's report, Mr. Fiehn grabbed him in the grain area further frightening the boy. The boy then reported the incident to the police. Fiehn, when questioned by the police, said there might have been a small scuffle and that he might have inadvertently touched the boy. Originally, Mr. Fiehn was charged with lewd conduct. Mr. Fiehn negotiated a settlement of the charge to "assault and battery" and pleaded guilty to that charge and paid a fine of \$150.00.

Because of these (2) allegations of unnatural behavior towards young male teenagers, it is my judgement that I should exercise the prerogative of removing Mr. Fiehn from the registration with the Boy Scouts of America and to send him a letter asking him to sever all ties. This certified letter was mailed on Thursday, June 6, 1991.

The procedures for a review of this decision are attached.

- 2. Upon the receipt of your written request, a committee will be appointed to review the situation.
- 3. You may attend the review hearing, but it is not adversarial in nature and neither the committee nor you will be represented by legal counsel. If you wish, you may be accompanied by no more than two other individuals if their testimony might assist the committee in discovering the truth and arriving at a correct decision.
- 4. The committee will review the facts as presented, and may interview any persons whose testimony might assist them in arriving at a correct decision.
- 5. You will receive a letter setting forth the decision of the committee.
- 6. If you disagree with the decision of the committee, you may request a review of this decision by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America.
