Man, 21, faces hearing on sex charge

COEUR d'ALENE — A 21-year-old man accused of lewd and lascivious conduct with a young boy is scheduled to appear for a preliminary hearing on the charge Monday in Shoshone County.

Vincent P. Frisbie, address unknown, remained in the Shoshone County Jail Wednesday in lieu of \$10,000 bail, jail officials said.

The criminal complaint charges Frisbie with having sexual contact with the boy, age unknown, on Jan. 24 in Shoshone County. The lewd and lascivious charge was filed March 27, according to the court clerk. court clerk.

Deputy Prosecutor Jack Rose said Wednesday he could not release any details of the case until after Frisbie's hearing Monday.

Kellogg man gets term for alleged lewd conduct

WALLACE — Vincent Paul Frisbie, 21, of Kellogg, was sentenced to an indeterminate five-year term for allegedly having lewd conduct with a minor child when he appeared in First District Court in Wallace Monday morning.

In handing down the maximum sentence, Judge Richard Magnuson retained jurisdiction for 120 days and ordered the defendant enrolled in a sexual offender program at the Idaho Board of Corrections facility in Cottonwood. Magnuson warned that Frisbie's stay in Cottonwood will more likely be nearer to six months, however, since he said officials there usually request a 60-day extension for treatment of cases related to child sexual abuse.

Frisbie was given credit for 18 days previously served, and his continued release on \$5,000 bond was authorized, pending enrollment, and transportation to Cottonwood. Monetary penalties include \$12.50 court costs, \$20 for victim's compensation fund and \$3 for the POST academy for law enforcement officers.

Public defense attorney Barry Watson, speaking on behalf of Frisbie, said a great number of changes in the defendant's lifestyle took place since August 1986 when he ceased having contact with a juvenile boy who was his alleged victim during the previous year. Watson described Frisbie as a "law-abiding citizen" who has dealt with a drinking problem through enrollment in alcohol abuse treatment programs.

Watson said Frisbie is "genuinely sorry" for his actions, to the extent of developing ulcers in the wake of feeling intense guilt and depression. He also said the defendant lost a job opportunity due to publicity associated with the case. He recommended a three-year term and a five-year probation, with orders for psychological treatment.

Shoshone County Prosecutor John Cossel countered by saying the court's primary concernshould be with the victim..."We cannot anticipate how that activity may affect the child in the future," Cossel said. He said Frisbie apparently used the authority that went with a supervisory position as a youth leader to develop a relationship that led to deviate behavior.

Asking that the maximum term be imposed as a means of maintaining control of the defendant for

a prolonged period, Cossel also recommended professional treatment, since he said persons with deviate behavior cannot be locked away or isolated from young children forever.

Magnuson followed Cossel's recommendations after saying, "This type of case causes the court a great deal of concern." He also noted that there now seems to be a greater incidence of this type of case than in previous years.

The sentence is designed to allow for rehabilitation and as a de-

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant be given credit for eighteen (18) days previously served in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant pay the sum of \$35.50 to the Clerk of the above-entitled Court as \$12.50 Court Costs, \$20.00 Victim's Compensation, and \$3.00 P.O.S.T. Fee.
